Messages from the Principal

Thank you for your quick response to the power outage we experienced on Tuesday, April 11th. At approximately 1:54pm the power went out and when we learned the power would possibly be off until 5pm we started to consider an early release process. As soon as we learned that we had no access to water which impacts health (flushing toilets and washing hands), we had to call an early release. If you did not receive the texts or DoJo messages, PLEASE call the main office at 720-424-8740 so we can solve the situation with you. In the event of any emergency, we need to have quick access to all parents and guardians. Thank you.

ECE Families

Please remember that sign-in for ECE is at 8am. Students at Colfax who have a first language other than English have the opportunity to start to prepare for the SEAL of Biliteracy which is an honor to be added to a student's high school diploma. High school feels like a long time away, but that day will be here before we all know it. In the meantime, our 5th grade students who are bilingual have the opportunity to earn an extra recognition and award for 5th grade Continuation.

Students prepare by demonstrating proficiency in different projects over the course of their time in elementary school, middle and then high school.
