AT Consideration

NLSEC AT Consideration and Trial Process
This process is designed to help you determine if a student is eligible for AT and if a device is needed. It is a collaborative process involving the student, family, and school personnel.

1. Identify the student's needs and goals.
2. Determine if the student is eligible for AT.
3. Identify potential AT devices.
4. Evaluate the student's needs and goals against the potential AT devices.
5. Determine if the student is eligible for AT.
6. Determine if the student is eligible for AT.
7. Determine if the student is eligible for AT.

SETT Document

SETT (Student Evaluation of Test Tools) is a document used to evaluate the effectiveness of a test. It is a collaborative process involving the student, family, and school personnel.
