

Rainout Information

- PSL uses the Rainout Line to let our teams know whether their games are on as scheduled or canceled
 - Each league has its own extension and Ky will include your league's extension in your opening day email
- The Rainout Line is updated each morning with the leagues that are scheduled to play that evening
- PSL staff will update the Rainout Line by 5pm on weekdays and 8am on weekends to let you know if your game is on as scheduled or canceled
- If there is rain in the forecast you should always check the Rainout Line before you leave for your game; once PSL staff calls games on for the evening, it's up to the league umpire to determine if the field is unplayable
 - If a field becomes unplayable after PSL calls games on the league umpire will let PSL staff know, and we will update the Rainout Line
- In the event there is a rainout during the season, your rained out games will be rescheduled for the end of the season and playoffs will be pushed back one week
 - Example: if softball games are rained out on 3/31, those games will be rescheduled for 5/5 and playoffs will be rescheduled for 5/12
 - If there are a significant number of rainouts during your season we will likely run double headers to keep your season on track
