2. Describe the image in a couple of sentences, words, or phrases.
 - a. Advertisement - movie poster, black and white, image of person standing in front of a wall that says "WE WON'T MOVE"
3. Starting the research process: Answer the following questions to help guide your research:
 - a. What story (or stories) can this object help illuminate?

Promotional poster for a film that tells the story about how "The Manong community of Manilatown in San Francisco [was] wiped out by urban renewal."

- b. What data might you need to help tell this story?

Historical data - understand the origins of the hotel itself, immigration data, government records, housing and zoning records

- c. What would your search terms be? (Hint: Your description of the item may be helpful for this, as will your answer to question A.)

Manong, Manilatown (SF), Urban renewal/gentrification, Filipino American History, Curtis Choy, The Fall of the I Hotel

4. Using the resources we've gone over in the class, find secondary resources.
