Module 1: The Five Senses (31 Lessons)

Essential Standards:

Module 2: Once Upon a Farm (32 Lessons)

T6 (FL.SC.6g)- Write words (inventive spelling is ok) or basic complete sentences. Focus on capital letters and end punctuation.

Module 4: Continents (36 Lessons)

T6 (FL.SC.6g)- Write in complete sentences. (Students should be able to write a complete sentence independently, using a sentence frame as necessary.

T6 (FL.SC.6h)- Capitalize the first word in a sentence and the pronoun I.

T6 (FL.SC.6i)- Ending punctuation
