

# Indian Visa Procedure - The General Requirements

India has strict entry requirements. Obtaining a visa for India can prove difficult if you do not follow these steps. Indian Ministry of External Affairs issues visas to Indian nationals who wish to visit India.

Visas cannot be issued on arrival. Visas are issued by the Indian missions abroad at their discretion and without payment of a non-refundable fee.



It is imperative that each country verify the credentials of any foreign visitor to the country, as borders are becoming increasingly porous. Each country's immigration authorities validate the credentials of foreign visitors by issuing a visa.

The visa allows the applicant to enter the country for a short time within the specified period, also noted on the visa. This is called tenure or validity of visa.

Indian Visas are required for foreign nationals who wish to visit India. This can be applied at any High Commission abroad. The High Commission can decide the visa fees and entry terms. They also have to consider the immigration laws that are in effect at the time of issue.

It is important to learn how to obtain an Indian visa in order to apply.

## **Caution**

\* A valid visa can be issued for up to six months. However, a tourist visa or business visa is only valid for six months.

\* The validity and validity of the visa are linked to the passport's validity. If the visa validity is greater than the validity of your passport, the visa will not be valid for the duration of your passport.

\* All visas are valid from the date they were issued.

\* A tourist visa may be granted for up to five years if the applicant is involved in the tourism industry.

\* Foreign nationals who have a visa valid for longer than 180 days must register with the Department of Immigration within 14 calendar days of their arrival [India Medical Visa](#).
