External links

To add external links:

Create an “External Links” section at the end of the article (==External Links==)

Use the “Link” menu item to add external links. Each link should be a **List item** in a “bullet” list

Example: *[<http://www.rigsum-it.com>] Rigsum Institute]

Citations

To enter a citation:

1. Go to the correct place in the article
2. Click on “Cite”
3. Click on “Templates”
4. Select “Web”
5. Enter details (Title, URL, Date)
6. Click “Insert”

Activity #4: Add References

1. Search Google for “Arunachal Pradesh to Thimphu film BICMA”
2. Copy the BICMA page web address (<http://www.bicma.gov.bt/paper/report.pdf>)
3. In the **lead section**, add a citation using the cite menu as follows

Arunachal Pradesh To Thimphu is a 2008 Bhutanese Dzongkha language film written and directed by Jigme Wangchuk^[1] , known by his stage name Jigme Ring.

4. Search Google for “Arunachal Pradesh to Thimphu award”
5. Copy the **bhutan.gov.bt** web address (www.bhutan.gov.bt/government/newsDetail.php?id=1214)
6. In the **Awards** section, add a citation using the cite menu as follows

"Best debutante actor award", 8th National Bhutanese Film Festival^[2]

7. Add a References section (==References==) . In the References section add:
