ABSTRACT

The abstract length should be a minimum of 150 words and a maximum of 250 words; it should be confined within a single paragraph. The first line of the abstract should not be indented from the left margin. The abstract should be double-spaced and typed in Times New Roman 12pt.

Keywords: keyword1, keyword2, keyword3, keyword4, keyword5 (list 3-5 keywords)

IPRC-2025: Abstract Guidelines

- **All participants are requested to follow the given guidelines to develop the content and format of their abstracts.**

I. The content for the submission of the abstract should have 4 main components:

- 1. Title:** consist of 12-15 words. Written in Font: Bold Times New Roman 14-point.
- 2. Author name, affiliation, and email**
 - 2.1. First Author's Name Surname^{1*}, Second Author's Name Surname², ...
 - 2.2. Author affiliation
Note: Students may mention the names of their supervisor/ advisor
 - 2.3. *Corresponding author email
- 3. Abstract Content- please follow the guidelines according to whether your research is based on completed research or it is a proposal.**
 - 3.1. Abstract Content for Completed Research/ Research Assignment**

The abstract should include the following (usually 1–2 sentences per topic):

 - introduction (problem statement and contribution)
 - research objective(s) or hypotheses
 - methods used (including brief descriptions of the study design, sample, data collection, and analysis)
 - main study results
 - implications (i.e., why this study is important, applications of the results or findings)
 - 3.2. Abstract Content for Research Proposal**

The abstract for the proposal should include the following (usually 1–2 sentences per topic):

 - introduction (problem statement and contribution)
 - research objective(s) or hypotheses
 - proposed methods (including brief descriptions of the study design, sample, data collection, and analysis)
 - proposed implications (i.e., why this study is important, and how you plan to apply of the results or findings).
- 4. Keywords: Need to specify 3 to 5 keywords of the research**

The keywords address essential research elements, such as: the research variables, the sample or context, the methods used

II. Abstract Format

- The abstract should be written in academic English.
- Submit abstract in word document.
 - Save the File with your Last Name-IPRC2025 (e.g. Smith-IPRC2025)
- Lines should be double-spaced.
- Font used should be Times New Roman, size 14- point for the title and size 12-point for the rest of the abstract content.
- The keywords should be lowercase (but capitalize proper nouns) and typed in *italic* 12-point Times New Roman. Each keyword should be separated by a comma and a space.
