This will be a "digital" presentation in Google. You must meet with your Advisor at least **1 week** before you present to have your final project evaluated. This will give you time to "fix" or improve any areas that need it.

If you do not meet with your advisor (at least one week) before you present, your project will not be accepted.

Please follow the guidelines listed on the next page. This is the order your slides should be in. It will take more than one slide to complete each part. You can have as many slides as it takes to describe your project and "tell your story".

Pictures or video are essential in providing evidence and makes your presentation much more enjoyable.

Pay close attention to your **LOG**. It must have DATES, TIMES, and A DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF WHAT YOU DID

The presentation format must have bullet points and be free of spelling errors and grammar mistakes.
