GENERAL INFORMATION

NEW for 2026 - TWO DAY Festival!

For 2026, we will be expanding our festival to TWO DAYS! Please register for whatever day you prefer. Availability is on a first come first serve basis; Register EARLY to ensure you get your preferred day!

Check-in & Parking:

Please see the attached map for parking areas. Parking is available in lot E1, off of Avenue K and 32nd St. West. Parking will be COMPLIMENTARY for this day–please DO NOT pay!

There will be a check-in table located in the ARTS QUAD behind the FA3 Building (follow signs) to drop off your scores & seating charts, pick up your welcome packet, and meet your ensemble host. The welcome packet will contain the most updated schedule.

Holding Area:

Weather permitting, the holding area will be outside in the **Arts Quad behind the FA3 Building.** Students are welcome to line up their **CASED-instruments** anywhere in the quad in an orderly fashion. We ask that you please be mindful of other bands' space, to avoid mixing instruments and confusion.

In inclement weather, holding areas will be moved to classrooms inside the FA3 building.

Warmup:

Warmup will be held in the **Band Room FA3-176.**

- All students should set up their instruments OUTSIDE IN THE QUAD, re-line up their empty cases OUTSIDE, and enter the warmup room with ONLY THEIR INSTRUMENTS AND MUSIC.
- ❖ Please *DO NOT BRING EMPTY CASES* into the warmup room.

Staging & Performance:

10 minutes before performance time, your ensemble host will guide you to the AVC performing arts theater for staging. Your performance time is the ENTIRE TIME you have on stage to set up, perform, and tear down. Please plan accordingly.

Clinic:

After performance, clinics with the adjudicators will be provided by the West Coast Performance Association. Clinics will be held in the Green Room backstage.

<u>Rating:</u>

Adjudication will be provided by the West Coast Performance Association. Ensembles will be rated **Superior (I)**, **Excellent (II)**, **Good (III)**, **Fair (IV)**, **and Poor (V)**. Ratings will be showcased in the Arts Quad.

Comments will be recorded and sent to each director post-performance. Sheets and scores will be returned back to the director by your ensemble host post-performance.

Spectators & Performer Re-Entry:

Parents, families, and performers (pre/post-performance) may enter through the front of the performing arts theater.

- Yes, you have to walk around to the front.
- We ask that spectating students be respectful and quiet during ALL performances.

Restrooms:

Restrooms will be open in the FA3 Building, Backstage, and Performing Arts Theater Lobby.

Ticket Price:

Concessions:

The AVC cafeteria will be open with many reasonably priced options. Schools may also elect to feed their students independently.

Special Guest Performance

Various Ensembles from the **Antelope Valley College Music Department** will be performing TWICE each day for all students to enjoy (Once at Lunch, Once at the end of the day). All students are HIGHLY ENCOURAGED to return to the theater and watch one of the performances.

Director Information

Registration Information:

- Register EARLY to ensure you get a spot on your preferred date!
- * Registration deadline: February 27th, 2026* or whenever spots are FILLED.
- * Registration fee: \$150 per ensemble. Invoice with payment info will be sent after registration.
- ❖ Payment due: Before you perform. Bring Cash or Check the day of is fine, but it must be CLEARLY LABELED in an envelope with your School/Ensemble name.

Scores/Seating Charts:

- Please plan to bring 3 Scores for each piece.
- Scores do not have to be original; photocopies are acceptable.
- Please have seating charts prepared with the number of chairs and stands needed.
 Seating chart template is available at the end of this packet, or use your own.

Percussion Information:

- ❖ Percussion may be VERY LIMITED during warmup; please plan accordingly.
- All LARGE PERCUSSION will be provided. Please indicate if you will need multiples on the registration form.
- Small percussion WILL NOT be provided. This includes Snare Drum, Concert Toms, Suspended cymbals, etc. Please plan to bring your own
- ❖ It is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED for all percussion instruments to be CLEARLY LABELED with school name. It is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED for small percussion instruments to be transported in a box, bin, or bag to minimize accidental loss.
- Percussionists may be able to enter the stage early, depending on the status of the preceding performance.

Selecting Music for Festival:

- There is NO REQUIRED MUSIC LIST. All music is acceptable, however please refrain from tunes that are too "pop"
- Groups may choose to perform one piece only but will receive Comments Only, rather than a rating
- A minimum of two selections are required to be awarded a rating (Superior, Excellent, Good, Fair, Poor)
- All groups are encouraged to perform three selections as long as the total performance time does not exceed 20 minutes, preferably not exceeding 18 minutes.


Thoughts on selecting music for performance

(following the recommendations of the Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association)

- Consider the practical ranges of your students and choose literature that doesn't exceed those ranges. If they are struggling with range, tone and intonation will most likely be affected.
- Avoid selections that feature instruments you don't have.
- Aim for variety in style, tonality and meter. Avoid tunes that all sound the same, have the same form, same key and/or tonality, by the same composer, etc.
- Consider the technical demands of the selections. If they are struggling with advanced technique, they will have trouble playing musically.
- Consider the total length of your program. Stay within your students' stamina/fatigue range.
- Consider your students' opinions about the literature. They don't have the musical education or sophistication that you do, but they do have a sense of what works for them and the group.
