**Lyft** is offering vouchers to help people get to and from shelters. The offer — up to two rides per person, worth up to \$25 per ride — is good for 500 riders and ends at midnight on Jan. 15. Use the code **CAFIRERELIEF25**

**Uber:** Residents in Los Angeles County who've been ordered to vacate their homes can get a credit from Uber to get to an evacuation site. The \$40 will only be valid for trips to an active shelter and by using the code **WILDFIRE25**

## **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND SMALL BUSINESS LOANS - VIA JUDY CHU'S OFFICE**

President Biden has issued a Major Disaster Declaration for the Los Angeles fires. I'm immensely grateful because this means that residents and businesses in wildfire evacuation zones in our area can apply NOW for immediate and long-term federal relief.

From Senator Judy Chu

I'm encouraging impacted Californians to apply for this immediate and long-term relief once safely out of the wildfires' paths. Our region's recovery will be long, but we're resilient. I want to assure you that my office stands with you and is here to help.

What does this relief include?

For residents and homeowners:

Temporary displacement assistance (e.g., hotel costs for up to two weeks)

\$770 for essential personal items

Larger direct grants to help cover essential needs such as medical bills, car repairs, and more

For businesses and homeowners:

Low-interest loans through the Small Business Administration (SBA) available at: <https://lending.sba.gov/search-disaster/?disaster=CA-20030>

FEMA will be at the Pasadena convention center today handing out 90% rental vouchers. These vouchers will be good for the next three years and will cover 90% of your rent, regardless of where you rent."

### **California Fire Foundation Wildfire & Disaster Relief Fund**

The [California Fire Foundation](#) works with local fire agencies and community based organizations to provide ongoing, mid- and long-term support to California communities affected by natural disasters like wildfires. The organization, which provides direct support to victims, is beginning to support those impacted by the Palisades Fire.

[World Central Kitchen](#), the nonprofit global food relief organization founded by celebrity chef José Andrés, is already on the ground in Southern California to aid first responders and evacuees. "Our teams have mobilized across the region to provide

immediate relief in the form of sandwiches and water as we identify all areas of need,” the organization said in a statement on Jan. 8.

### **Salvation Army**

The Salvation Army operates a disaster services fund that directly supports evacuees and first responders of California wildfires. The organization provides emergency relief and long-term assistance to those impacted by natural disasters.

### **GoFundMe**

The online fundraising platform GoFundMe has created a centralized hub of verified fundraising pages on its site. The list is updated by the platform's Trust & Safety team to ensure that all included fundraisers are authentic. GoFundMe has also launched its own 2025 Wildfire Relief Fund, and says that all money raised will go directly to impacted people who are seeking help through GoFundMe fundraisers, and to nonprofit organizations providing relief on the ground.

### **California Community Foundation**

The California Community Foundation has been working to strengthen Los Angeles County since 1915. The organization's Wildfire Recovery Fund targets the most underserved and hard to reach communities in the region, with the goal of helping provide long-term recovery relief.

### **CAL FIRE Benevolent Foundation**

CAL FIRE Benevolent Foundation provides financial aid to firefighters and their families in the case of injury or loss of life. The organization also helps support burn victims and their families, along with research focused on firefighter health and safety.
