Herbicide Application Notice

Dear Lake Forest School District Parents, Staff, and Community:

Lake Forest School Districts 67 and 115 practice Integrated Pest Management, a program that combines preventative techniques with a preference for products that are the least harmful to human health and the environment. The State of Illinois requires all schools to notify parents/staff at least 48 hours prior to any pesticide applications on school property.

To control weeds on our grassy areas, including our sports fields, a broadleaf herbicide application will take place at both Lake Forest High School East Campus, located at 1285 N. McKinley Rd, and Lake Forest High School West Campus, located at 300 S. Waukegan Rd, the week of August 4th - August 8th, weather permitting. This application will take 2-3 days to complete. Our 5-day notice allows us to adjust the application time in the event of inclement weather.

Registry
