- I'm interested in hearing whether anyone has decided to "wholeheartedly" adopt Team Drives as it stands now, or whether you're still taking a "wait and see" approach
  - Using it at Perry quite a bit in the last few months and I love it! We were early adopters and we've gotten some great feedback from teachers.
  - OP: My biggest concern is that we have many use cases that would make "Team Drive within Team Drive" useful; the alternative would be a very large list of individual Team Drives at the top level...
  - Perry: I'm pretty sure I understand what you're asking, we have a few building level "Teams" and a few unique teams. There are features within the team that allows you to set permissions on individual folders. What makes the team nice is that it provides a platform for quick referencing your groups. Think of the thumbnails like Google Classroom; I click the icon for my LA Team and there is everything I need for LA in folders. I currently use 4 teams for my own usage and it is organized in an easy, not-overwhelming, format. Team Drive does not replace the "My Drive" area. It just enhances the sharing experience.'
  - OP: Thanks for trying, Eric...I'll wait and watch. My use case (university) is "Team Drive" for all faculty, then, e.g. committee subfolders. Thanks for suggestions, Perry.
- Will the new chat within docs be included in Google Vault?
  - I didn't see anything either, but I would assume it would because Hangouts text features are included in Vault. It is handy as students do like to use chat from time to time in docs. It isn't a problem as long as students are being responsible, but it would be nice to be able to say to students that all conversations are documented.
