Online exam registration will begin on Wednesday, Oct 6, 2021 at 8:00 AM and end on Wednesday, Nov 10, 2021 at 11:59 PM. In order to register, students should visit [www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/221255](http://www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/221255). To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. It is strongly recommended that students use the same registration information used to join your AP class(es), i.e., same email, password, and join code. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the

end. We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.
