 - A: the power of student voice and how these changes excite them about learning

SAMR Technology Implementation Scale - where are you on the

- Plan is focused on Innovation and team learning developed through collaboration
- Trying to put the PD for teachers online (badging), but struggling to determine option
- Annual State of the District is recorded and chunked into Youtube videos based on topics. They also have implemented an "Ask Tracy/Supt" site where parents can input questions. The Supt then answers question via Youtube video and posts information to the community.
