Help Secure Funding for a Permanent Wildlife Crossing on Chileno Valley Road

Right now, the Transportation Authority of Marin (TAM) is deciding how to spend Measure AA transportation funds. This only happens once every six years, and decisions will be finalized in early March.

We are asking TAM to fund a planning grant to design a permanent wildlife crossing under Chileno Valley Road—the step that will make construction possible later.

Your voice matters. **This action takes 10 minutes and collectively creates significant pressure on decision-makers.**

All comments are due by March 9th!

How to send:

Dear [Commissioner / TAM Board],

I'm writing to urge you to support funding for a planning grant for a permanent wildlife crossing on Chileno Valley Road.

Each year, thousands of animals are killed trying to cross this road to reach Laguna Lake. Volunteers have stepped in to help, but this is not a long-term or scalable solution.

Funding planning now allows wildlife crossing improvements to be included when the road is repaired, saving time and public money later. Measure AA was approved to maintain roads while also protecting environmental quality, and this project clearly does both.

Please include language in the Measure AA reimagine roadways expenditure plan review to address wildlife connectivity as it pertains to roads in Marin County.
