5 mins	Set up the video to watch. Students seated on the floor.	
5 mins	Introduce the topic - Revision Today as part of our revision for signs we have learnt this term we will see some of our Deaf presenters being interviewed. They will be asked questions about their favourite food, colours, and way to travel. Also the last shop they'd been to and what they bought, etc. Watch to see which signs you recognise.  (Start of Lesson)  Read and discuss the Learning Intention and Success Criteria.  Check for understanding, clarifying vocabulary as necessary.	Provided above
10 mins	Explicit Teaching: Watch the video  Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time.  Lesson: Revision of signs learnt, through interviews of our Deaf presenters.	#B Lesson 10 video
5 mins	<ul> <li>Explanation of Activity:</li> <li>Discussion of the interviews on the video with the class and teacher. What questions were asked and some of the answers. (see right side column for Q and A)</li> <li>This will assist the students to conduct their own interview.</li> <li>With a partner the students will ask and answer interview questions in Auslan, as in the video, e.g. favourite breakfast, favourite travel etc</li> <li>Please remember 'voices off' during the interviewing.</li> <li>Report back to the class at the end - what did you find out about your partner?</li> </ul>	Interview Q and A: Favourite breakfast?
