a. Our System, Our Structure, Our Illusion (2h24m20s)

• OUR SYSTEM OUR STRUCTURE OUR ILLUSION (2010) from Dominoes Falling Productions, is a feature length documentary using a collaboration of various material. The film presents an alternative outlook of contemporary society, in particular UK & US, however parallels can be made to nearly every society that exists today. Are we economic/corporate slaves to a monetary system? The film challenges established beliefs, values and structures imposed on many, as well as people's attachment to the roles they play in this.

a. Collapse (1h20m45s)

• Sitting in a room that looks like a bunker, Ruppert recounts his career as a radical thinker and spells out the crises he sees ahead. He draws upon the same news reports and data available to any Internet user, but he applies a unique interpretation. He is especially passionate about the issue of "peak oil," the concern raised by scientists since the seventies that the world will eventually run out of fossil fuel. While other experts debate this issue in measured tones, Rupperts doesn't hold back at sounding an alarm, portraying an apocalyptic future. Listening to his rapid flow of opinions, the viewer is likely to question some of the rhetoric as paranoid or deluded, and to sway back and forth on what to make of the extremism. Smith lets viewers form their own judgments.

b. A Crude Awakening: The Oil Crash (1h22m51s)

c. The End of Suburbia (1h17m37s)

• The modern suburbs have ultimately become an unsustainable way of living. They were originally developed in an era of cheap oil, when the automobile became the center of the way people lived and an era when people wanted to escape the inner city to a more pastoral or rural way of life. However the suburbs quickly evolved into a merely a place to live that had neither the benefits of rural or urban life, and where one was reliant on an automobile both to travel elsewhere and even travel within the neighborhood. The suburbs are not only dependent upon cheap energy, but also reliable energy.

d. **GasLand** (1h42m41s)

• It is happening all across America-rural landowners wake up one day to find a lucrative offer from an energy company wanting to lease their property. Reason? The company hopes to tap into a reservoir dubbed the "Saudi Arabia of natural gas." Halliburton developed a way to get the gas out of the ground-a hydraulic drilling process called "fracking"-and suddenly America finds itself on the precipice of becoming an energy superpower.

e. Sweet Crude (1h33m02s)

• Despite the valuable crude oil that flows from the ground beneath their feet, the impoverished villagers in the Niger Delta wage a daily struggle to survive. This Seattle-made documentary journeys to the region to examine the complex powder keg situation that could have drastic local and global effects

a. Dan Aykroyd: Unplugged on UFOs (1h21m11s)

David Serada, a UFO enthusiast, interviews the comedian Dan Aykroyd who claims he
has had experiences with alien beings. Aykroyd expounds on UFO lore and his own
beliefs on matters related to extraterrestrials. Footage of this interview is interspersed
with video and film of these flying objects; video clips of a former Canadian defense
minister speaking on the subject; audio clips of astronauts speaking of strange things.

b. The Secret UFO NASA Transmissions – The Smoking Gun (1h29m09s)

• EBE Award Winner! Best Film - International UFO Congress Film Festival. This program presents the history of UFO sightings by NASA Astronauts and the facts around a secret independent study to monitor the digital video cameras on all NASA Space Shuttle missions.
