STP Action and Research Plan September 2018

Your Action Plan for the STP is due on Monday, Sept. 24 (Day 1), or Tuesday, Sept. 25 (Day 2). Take the following steps to write the Action Plan. It should be organized in bullet points.

- 1. Describe the current state of the topic you are working on or are going to start working on for the STP.
- 2. Describe the form that your research writing will take (e.g., research paper, exhibition labels, web site, documentary screenplay, etc. See the STP Handbook for more details.)
- 3. Describe whether your STP involves an activity besides research writing (volunteer, work, conduct an experiment, filming a documentary, etc.), or if you are only writing a research paper.
- 4. Describe where you want the STP (both the research writing and the activity) to be when you finish it.
- 5. Describe what you need to do get your STP, both the research writing and the activity you're pursuing, where you want it to be when it is finished. Break this down into incremental steps, and establish target dates for each step.
- 6. Address any needs (space, time, assistance, transportation, etc.) and potential obstacles that might arise along each of the steps detailed in the previous stage.
- 7. Identify how you will know that you have fulfilled the Action and Research Plan. What will it look like when it is completed?
