

Based on the information from the Edway Training page on the "Supervise Asbestos Removal Course" in Melbourne, here are some frequently asked questions (FAQs) in a simple list format:

1. **What is the Supervise Asbestos Removal Course?**

- This course is designed to specify the outcomes required to supervise the removal process for friable and non-friable asbestos-containing material (ACM). It's essential for large-scale (over 10 sqm) asbestos removal work, which cannot be undertaken without the presence of an asbestos safety supervisor.

2. **Who delivers the Supervise Asbestos Removal training course?**

- The training course is delivered by Edway Training (RTO No 91401), approved by the Australian Skills and Quality Authority (ASQA) to deliver this training course.

4. **What will participants receive upon successful completion of the course?**

- Participants will receive a Statement of Attainment and a plastic card issued by Edway Training on the day of training.

5. **What topics does the Asbestos Safety Supervisor training cover?**

- The training covers generating an Asbestos Removal Plan, preparing worksite for Asbestos Removal, supervising asbestos testing, documentation, and compliance, supporting team members, ensuring safe removal and decontamination processes, and compliance with legislation and WHS processes.

6. **Is the Statement of Attainment nationally recognised?**

- Yes, the Statement of Attainment is nationally recognised, though additional training might be required in different states. It's advised to refer to the local authority for more information.

7. **What are the payment options for the course?**

- The course can be paid online or through invoice for companies and employment agencies, with both options requiring a payment of \$300.

8. **What are the pre-requisite training requirements?**

- Participants must hold specific units of competency related to working safely in the construction industry and asbestos removal. A current white card and statement of attainment for non-friable and/or friable asbestos removal must be presented on the day of training.

9. **What identification is required to attend the course?**

- Participants must provide one form of photo ID (e.g., passport, Australian driver's licence, proof of age card, student card).

10. **Are there any specific clothing requirements for the course?**

- Yes, participants are required to wear closed-toed comfortable shoes to complete this course.

11. **\*\*Does the course include a practical assessment?\***

- Yes, the course consists of both theory-based and practical assessments.
