Then, hear from the Issue Refinement Group regarding edits made to the list. Without having to re-approve the whole list, discuss and offer support (or lack thereof) on the changes made to the list since the August meeting. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Expectation: No prior preparation is needed from Collaborative members.</i> <i>Objective: At the end of this agenda item, the Collaborative should know that the provisions to consensus on the Issues List have been addressed and have an idea of whether full consensus was achieved.</i>
