One Day Academy exists to:

- Strengthen parents in **Christian** training, mentoring, and discipling their children.
- Promote a safe environment where learning is encouraged and Godly character is admired.
- Equip students with college-level academics and expectations.
- Model Christ's example to young people through our teachers, administrators, and church staff.
- Extend friendship, guidance, and support through communities of like-minded individuals who hold the church in high regard and appreciate its generosity in allowing us to use their property.

The following policies are in place for our 2025-2026 academic year:

- Students may eat lunch and play board games, cards, etc., in the Student Area.
- Students may use the time to work on school subjects or visit with friends.
- Students will stay in designated supervised areas.
- Students may not disrupt church offices, classes, or others.
- **No wheels on campus.** For the safety of students, please keep all skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, and wheelies at home.
- **Teen drivers** may not drive a motor vehicle with more than one passenger in the car under 21 who is not a family member per Texas state law.
- Parents and siblings are only allowed on campus if escorted by staff, faculty, or supervisors to ensure the safety of students on campus.

ELECTRONICS/STUDY HALL:

- Students will be respectful to Staff, Faculty, and Supervisors when asked about an electronic device.
- Staff, Faculty, and Supervisors maintain the right to review and supervise any media deemed necessary.
- **Mobile phones will be silenced, put away, and not visible (this includes other electronic devices, too)**
- Cell phones can be in backpacks and used only at the Sign-In table should the student need to text or call parents.
- Texting and video recording are prohibited during campus hours (8-4:30 PM).
- Students must use laptops and tablets for schoolwork only - and only in the Study Hall.
- Students must NOT sit along the side of the walls using their phones.
- Students MAY only have cell phones out during class if requested by faculty or if a medical emergency exists.

- Students MAY NOT share screens OR headphones with other students
- Students MAY NOT bring gaming devices; this includes DS, Nintendo Switch, etc.
- Students are not to use the church Wi-Fi (internet) unless they have permission to do so from the Supervisor.
- As indicated in our [ODA policies](#), cell phones may be confiscated until the end of the day.
- Students and parents must understand that there are certain risks (including, but not limited to, damage and loss) that are implicit with bringing electronic equipment to campus, and ODA assumes no liability for student devices.

Parents have differing opinions on what their students can and cannot view online, so students are required to follow the rules and refrain from sharing screens.

CONSEQUENCES:

- As indicated in our [ODA policies](#), cell phones may be confiscated until the end of the day.
- If the media is inappropriate, the parent will be contacted, and appropriate action will be taken.
- **Any phone in view and on-site will be confiscated, logged, and securely held until the student or parent can collect it at the end of the day.**
- Any policy-breaking will result in write-ups following the discipline procedures in our [ODA Policies](#).

TEEN DRIVERS:

If you are between 16 and 17 years of age and are transferring/presenting a provisional driver's license, you will be issued a Texas provisional driver's license.

These individuals may not drive a motor vehicle with more than one passenger in the car under the age of 21 who is not a family member.

TUITION:

- Please recognize that our courses cover a 34-week calendar, and our faculty allows payments over nine months as a convenience for families.
- Tuition is due on the first day of the month, August-April.

BANNOCKBURN SPECIFIC POLICIES:

- No loitering in the parking lot, on the stairs, or the hallways before class
- Students must always be in direct view of a Supervisor and are responsible for ensuring they can be seen.
- Students may only enter the building through the front door of the Education Building and NOT the gate. They may also only enter and exit through the front door of the Education Building, unless escorted by staff, faculty, or a supervisor. The gate is to be used only to help a teacher or if there is an emergency (such as fire, tornado, etc.).

- Students may not use the kitchen; only faculty and supervisors may use the kitchen.
- Students may leave campus in a vehicle only. No walk-offs are allowed.
- Students are not permitted to sit in cars or hang out in the parking lot.
- Students may help set up the campus starting at 8 AM to earn volunteer hours. Campus opens at 8:15 a.m. Campus closes at 4:30 p.m. Students will keep track of their community service hours in the community service log binder.

SOUTH AUSTIN CHURCH SPECIFIC POLICIES:

- No loitering on stairs or hallways before class
- Students must always be in direct view of a Supervisor and are responsible for ensuring they can be seen.
- Students may only enter the building through the back door of the Main building. They may also only enter and exit through the back door of the Main building, unless escorted by staff, faculty, or a supervisor. All other doors may only be used in helping a teacher or if there is an emergency (such as fire, tornado, etc.).
- Students may not use the kitchen; only faculty and supervisors may use the kitchen.
- Students may leave campus in a vehicle only. No walk-offs are allowed.
- Students are not permitted to sit in cars or hang out in the parking lot.
- Students may help set up the campus starting at 8 AM to earn volunteer hours. Campus opens at 8:15 a.m. Campus closes at 4:30 p.m. Students will keep track of their community service hours in the community service log binder.
- All faculty, staff, parents, and students **MUST** enter South Austin Church from Barge Street. ODA will use the second turn to access the second parking lot area behind South Austin Church.
- All faculty, staff, parents, and students **MUST** exit South Austin Church using Barge Street.
- All faculty, staff, parents and students **MUST** enter the parking lot by way of BARGE Street and using the 2nd Right.
- All faculty, staff, parents and students **MUST** exit by turning **RIGHT** on Menchaca Road when leaving campus; **NO LEFT TURNS ONTO MENCHACA ROAD**. Instead, you **MUST** turn **RIGHT** on Menchaca Road, **RIGHT** on Miles Avenue, **RIGHT** on Cannonleague Drive, and **RIGHT** onto William Cannon.
