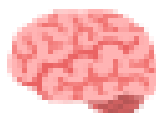

SCHOOL INFO

ATTENDANCE: Student absences must be reported by a parent/guardian by 9:00 a.m. You may use the online tool (Cudahy School District website -cudahysd.org) [CHS Student Absence Report Form](#) or call (414) 294-2705.



BUS: Students approved to ride the CHS bus must live 2.0 miles or more away from CHS. The 2.0 miles will be strictly enforced. The 2.0 miles will be determined by Google maps most direct route. The CHS bus is not available to students living outside the city limits of Cudahy. Apply here... [Bus Application](#). Once approved, have your student ID stamped for use as a bus pass. EARLY RELEASE: If your student will be leaving school early for an appointment please contact the school before 9:00 a.m. (using online reporting tool [CHS Student Absence Report Form](#) or phone) to request a pass. The student will be given the pass between classes.

LATE START FRIDAYS -NEW SCHEDULE! Teachers will meet in collaborative teams on the **Fridays** listed on the link. Classes will start later (8:25 am) on these specific Fridays. The building is open starting at 7:15 am every day, so there is no need to change a student's arrival time on any day.

MEDICATION: If your child has a health condition that will require medication to be taken at school you must complete the [medication form](#), including signatures from the prescribing doctor and parent.
