

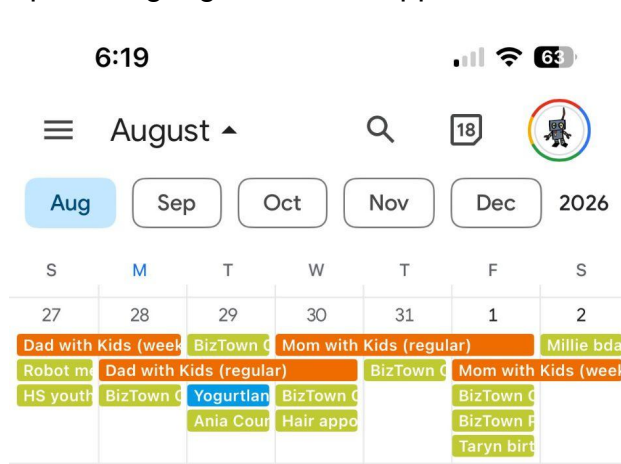
This guide contains instructions on how to add our calendar to your Google Calendar mobile and desktop, in addition to instructions to add our calendar for other calendar providers.

If you use Google Calendar on Mobile (alternative services see further below):

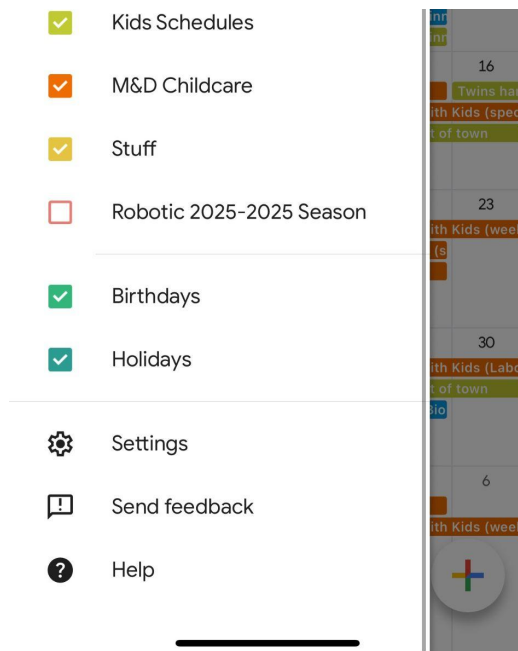
1. First things first, you need to make sure you have the Google Calendar app downloaded.



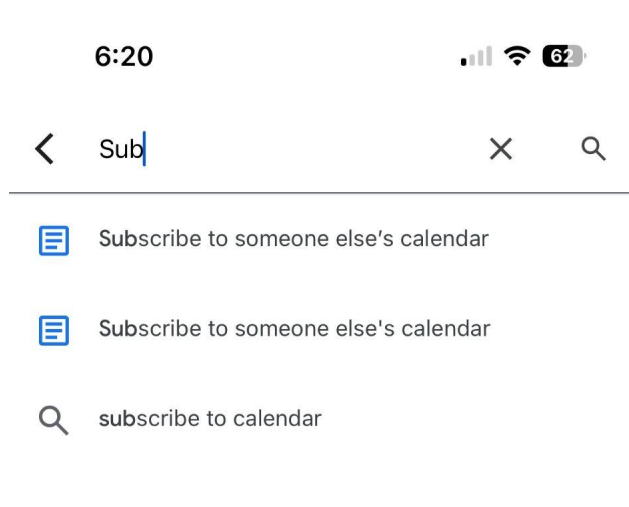
2. Open the google calendar app and click the three bars in the top left corner.



3. Scroll down this section and click the help button at the very bottom.



4. Look up and click “subscribe to someone else’s calendar”.



5. Under “Show or hide a calendar you’re subscribed to” click the link taking you to “calendar.google.com”.



Subscribe to someone else's calendar

In Google Calendar, you can subscribe to someone else's calendar if they share it with you. If someone hasn't shared their calendar with you, you can ask for access to their primary calendar.

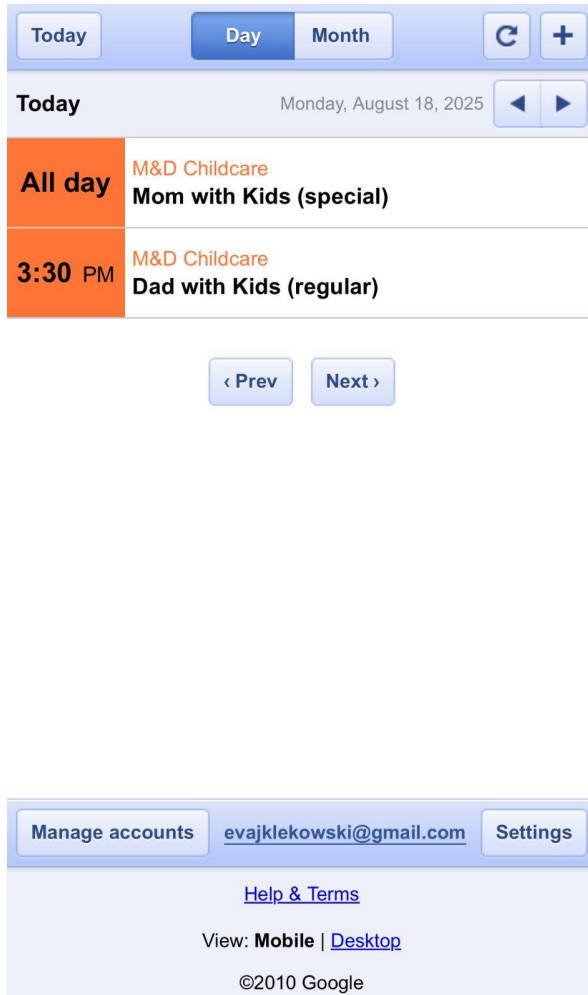
Show or hide a calendar you're subscribed to

Important: You can only subscribe to a calendar from calendar.google.com .

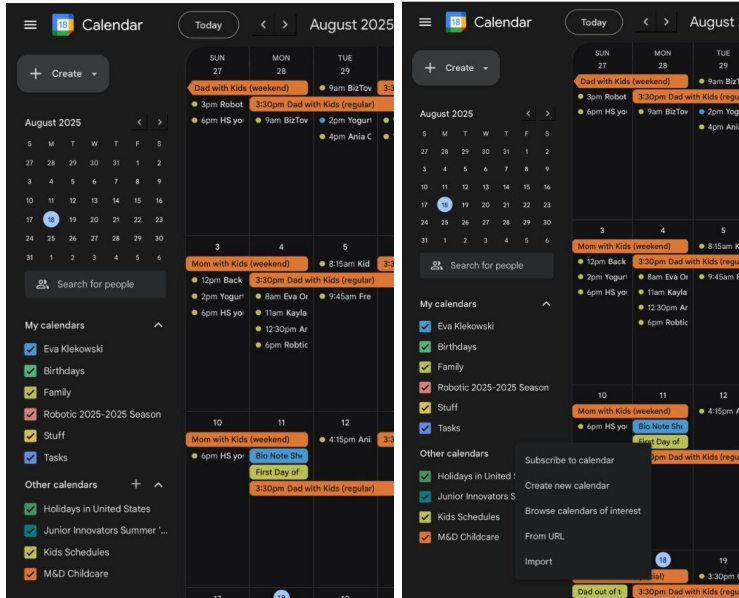
1. On your iPhone or iPad, open the Google Calendar app .
2. At the top left, tap Menu .
3. To the left of a calendar, check or uncheck the box.

Add a calendar someone shared

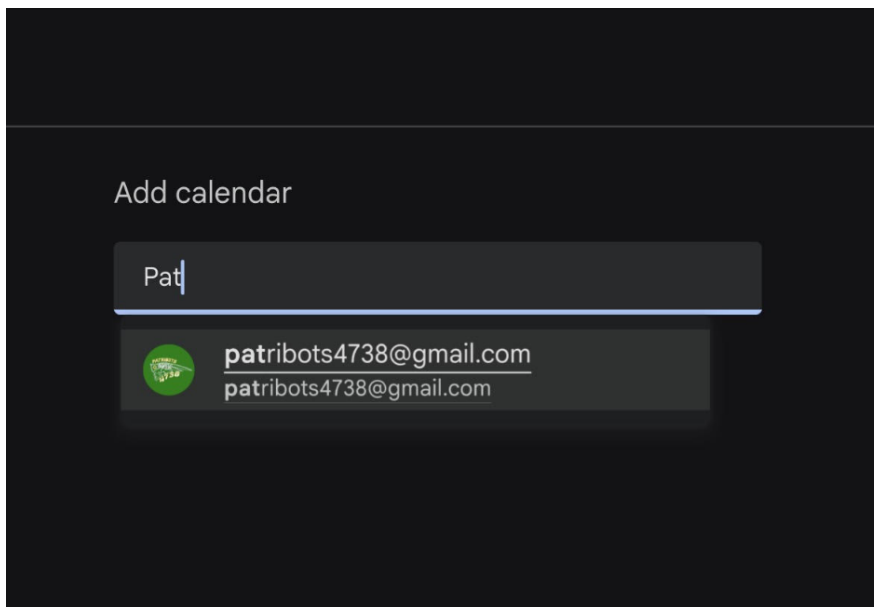
6. This should bring you to a strange looking website that looks like it was made 20 years ago. Down at the bottom of the screen, click the blue highlighted "Desktop" button.



7. This will take you to a more normal looking version of google calendar that is a big squished. You're going to click the plus next to "Other calendars" and then click "Subscribe to calendar".



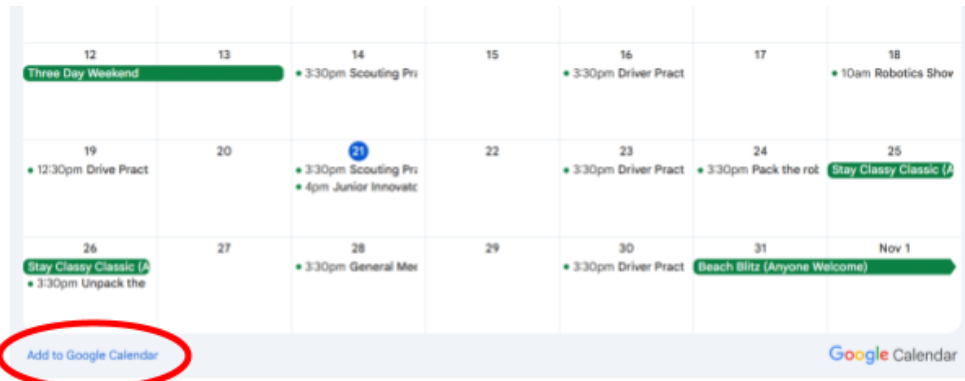
8. In the text box, type in “patribots4738@gmail.com” and click it.



9. You now have the calendar added!
10. Any google calendar app on any device attached to your google account will have this calendar.

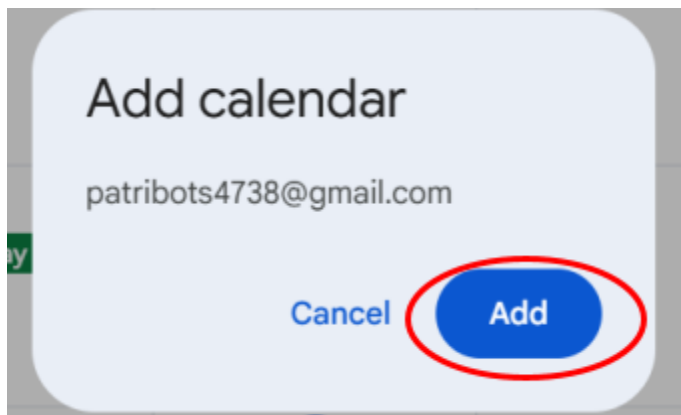
If you use Google Calendar on Desktop

1. Go back to [our website](#) and click on “Add to Google Calendar”.

2. Your Google Calendar will open (you might need to sign in), and then this will show up. Click “Add”.

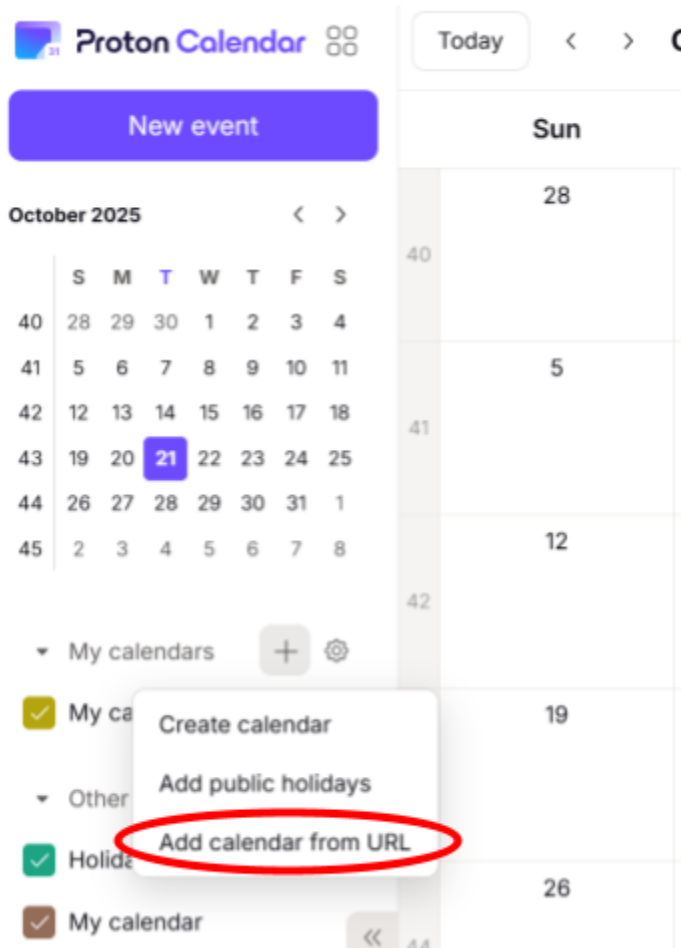


3. Our calendar was just added! Events will load and sync automatically as long as you have an internet connection. Any device attached with your (not ours, your) Google Account will see this calendar when logged in.

If you DO NOT use Google Calendar (if you use another calendar service):

Note: Proton Calendar is just an example, other services do this too!

1. In your calendar, often in a side menu, find where it says to add a calendar by url or add a calendar by ics and click on it



- a. Note: Many (not all) services require you to use a computer to do this step, so this might be why you don't find it on your mobile app
2. Copy and paste in this url:
<https://calendar.google.com/calendar/ical/patribots4738%40gmail.com/public/basic.ics>
3. Click continue. The Patribot's calendar will now begin to import, and from here, it will automatically update from the main calendar within 8 hours.
