- Educators for a United Ireland is a cross community group of educators from across Britain and the island of Ireland
- The continued partition of Ireland impedes social, economic, and political progress, sustaining division and instability.
- Genuine Irish unity must be tied to a program of economic and social justice, recognizing that worker exploitation, north and south, is rooted in ongoing capitalist interests. We affirm James Connolly's principle: "the cause of Labour is the cause of Ireland, the cause of Ireland is the cause of Labour."
- Sectarianism is a deliberate political tool used to fracture working-class solidarity.

- Brexit has heightened political and economic instability, exposing partition's detrimental effects on workers' rights and cross-border cooperation.
- Radical Irish leaders, from Wolfe Tone to James Connolly, have historically linked liberation to dismantling exploitative economic interests.
- Connolly's vision of a Democratic Socialist Republic offers the best framework for an equitable, unified, and sustainable future for all in Ireland. The NEU has an essential role in educating its members and the community on political issues impacting workers and social justice.
