1) Treasurer's Report

- a) Change membership to one option status
 - i) Going well with some manual intervention required
- **b)** Donate button on WApricot
 - i) Allen P volunteered to look into this perhaps using fund raising software he has used before. Will also look at Wild Apricot's (WA) ability to handle donations
- c) Quarterly financial report
 - i) Through July
 - (1) Income \$30,705
 - (2) Total expense \$12,397
 - ii) About \$56K on hand but much of that amount is for Sequanota reservations
- 2) Membership
 - a) We now have approximately 600 members, but numbers may be reducing.
 According to WA
 - b) Hard to give exact number as many memberships are coming up for renewal
- 3) Liability and Directors & Officers insurance
 - a) Allen P reached out to two insurance brokers concerning these policy types and received quotes and sample policies.


- ii) If Rod Tulloss is at NEMF in Ithaca, Tom plans to ask him about the status of Amanita banningiana (prov).
