This small group setting will allow the counselors an opportunity to interact with students and answer questions regarding:

- Educational Development Plans (EDP)
- Graduation requirements and elective options
- Honors and prerequisite sequencing

Students and parents will have the opportunity to discuss course options at home. Students will register for courses at the middle school, bring home a printed list of their course requests, and return the signed form to the middle school.
