





	Sora eBooks & AudioBooks	 Students and staff can download the app onto their personal device. When it asks for your school, type in "Hillsboro School District." It will then prompt you to log-in through ClassLink/Google. Use your HSD username and password. You can also access Sora on a desktop through myapps.hsd.k12.or.us. (Look for the blue Sora icon.) Here are instructions for students/parents in both English and Spanish. Sora has given us access to over 200 "simultaneous use" ebooks/audiobooks which means the titles are open to all without waits. See below for titles.

New titles for K-5 are being added every few days including fiction and nonfiction read-alongs, picture books, eBooks, and audiobooks. Click <u>"all Spanish titles"</u> curated collection for all Spanish ebooks and audiobooks. Click "Always Available" collection to see the 400+ titles that have unlimited access Always Available! OverDrive has donated a collection of simultaneous, always available titles. These titles have unlimited copies and no waits.
