A former All-Conference middle in high school (Elder HS) and college (University of Dayton Men's Club), he has since turned his focus to coaching, working with every level from new elementary school players through men's collegiate varsity teams over the past 15 years. Most recently, Nick led the Elevation 18-Toth team to the championship match for the USA Volleyball 18s Championships (National division) and served as an assistant coach for the Kings HS varsity team as they became the first SW Ohio public school to win a Division I State Championship since 1994. A former attorney, Nick has now turned volleyball into his full time profession, serving as the Operations Director for the National Collegiate Volleyball Federation and the Event Director for their 550+ team national championship tournament each spring.
