

Western Wars Site Rules

1. No open containers. Drinks must be in period containers or appropriate mugs outside of camps and cabins. Please consider separating and bagging your recyclable cans and bottles in your camp for easy disposal by the event staff.
2. Dogs are allowed in County Parks, but must remain leashed and attended at all times. Do not leave your dogs unattended, even if tied to a lead. If any member of the Western Wars staff finds your dog unattended or improperly restrained, or if your dog exhibits any sort of inappropriate behavior, you will be asked to remove your dog from the event, and may be asked to leave entirely. This is a **no tolerance** policy. Please think long and hard about whether or not your dog is able to behave within these requirements – if you have any doubts, please leave them at home.
3. No smoking of any kind inside structures including restrooms, cabins and the lodge.
4. No campfires outside of designated fire pits. Each Camp Wilkerson campsite has a picnic table and fire ring. Western Wars will have a large main fire open to all near the lodge.
5. Parking:
Guests are welcome to unload near camping and community locations. Once cars are unloaded, they should be moved to the designated parking locations for the duration of your stay. **Maximum speed is 10 mph on camp property.** Use caution and watch for campers and guests.
6. Cars, Motorcycles, and off-road vehicles, are prohibited on trails, roads, and in camps outside of the designated parking spaces.
7. This is a wildlife and wildflower preserve. The feeding of animals and picking of flowers are prohibited. This upsets the balance of nature; animals can easily become ill or dependent upon inappropriate foods. Flowers are best left in their natural settings. Plants can fail to reproduce if flowers are removed. “Leave Living The Things That Are Living!”
8. Trash and Litter:
There is at least one garbage can located at each building. Separated recycling will be collected at the end of the event. You must keep your camp clean and free of litter at all times. If you leave behind substantial litter and trash in your camp, you may be asked to not come back.
If you see litter, you must pick it up. Litter is unsightly and mars the land.
9. Buildings:

When buildings are not in use lights and heaters should be turned off. Please be sure that furnishings are not moved around, out of, or between buildings. This includes deck chairs, mattresses, and picnic tables.

10. Restrooms:

The restrooms are to be cleaned and stocked with paper products and soap by Western Wars Staff. Please help us serve you by reporting any maintenance issues or disrepair.

11. Showers:

To conserve hot water and accommodate other campers, please be courteous and limit your shower time to 15 minutes.
