VII. Band Events Currently "On Hold":

Performing Arts Trip to Walt Disney World – POSTPONED -

Virtual Band Picnic - Going to try to move away from this and develop other activities, the in person picnic is likely not going to happen.

Symphonic Band Playing for Graduation - We are awaiting information and decisions regarding plans for graduation. Once we know more, we can figure out the band's role in the graduation ceremony.

VIII. New Business:

Harrisonburg Band Boosters 2020 Scholarships -

Senior Scholarships - There will be four senior scholarships. Current 12th grade band and color guard students are eligible to apply.

Summer Scholarships - There is still uncertainty about summer band camp opportunities. Current 9th-11th grade band and color guard students may apply for summer camp scholarships.

All scholarship applications will be available May 1, and completed applications are due May 15, 2020. The Scholarship Committee will collaborate via email to review Senior Scholarship applications and select recipients.

Marching Band Registration (formerly Marching Band Orientation) - We will still host a virtual orientation, probably multiple opportunities. Mr. Upton is working through electronic registration options. **no band fees will be collected at this time due to so many unknowns. Will likely collect at band camp.

Upton and Leeper are working to connect with incoming 8th graders, utilizing the leadership team for help.

Virtual Spring Concert - Submissions are due to Mr. Upton by Wednesday, May 20, 2020. The Virtual Spring Concert webcast date will be announced later (*tentatively late May/early June*).

Virtual Music Banquet - Directors will work on this along with other music faculty as previously announced.

Marching Band Camp - Band camp dates have been set for August. Once we have an accurate count of the number of marchers, we can make plans for meals and uniform fittings. We will need Band Booster volunteers for a successful camp experience!
