

Dr. Ahmad Nasef Scholarship Program Guidelines

(Minimum \$1,500 in Scholarships Available)

The Dr.Ahmad Nasef Scholarship Program; one of the charitable arms of Hanan Refugees Relief Group, announces the 2025 Hanan Refugees Relief Group: Dr. Ahmad Nasef Scholarship Awards Program. Refugee and Immigrant students are eligible to apply; please read the following program guidelines and priorities.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- Scholarship is open to graduating high-school seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0, a total family annual income under \$75,000, and plan to attend a 2-or-4 year university, community college, college or technical school.
- Must be a refugee or immigrant to the United States to qualify for scholarship, citizenship is not required.
- Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program.
- The application deadline is 6/13/2025. Late applications will not be accepted.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college in August 2025 or January 2026 for the second semester of the student's first year.
- Once received, it will be the student's responsibility to submit to the Hanan Refugees Relief Group an invoice for second semester tuition and fees, student ID number and college information.

The applications will be reviewed, and recipients selected by the Scholarship Committee of Hanan Refugees Relief Group. Scholarships will be awarded in August 2025. All applicants will be notified whether or not they won a scholarship.
