Subject: Urgent Concerns Regarding Unsafe Parking Outside Overstone Combined School, Church Street, Wing, LU& ONY

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to formally raise concerns regarding ongoing unsafe and inconsiderate parking outside **Overstone Combined School**, particularly during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up times.

Over recent months, we have observed a significant increase in unsafe and inconsiderate parking in the vicinity of the school. Vehicles are frequently:

- Vehicles parking on double yellow lines and across driveways
- Cars stopping on corners and junctions, reducing visibility
- Vehicles mounting pavements, forcing pedestrians—including children and parents with pushchairs—into the road
- Parking on corners and near junctions
- Obstructing visibility for pedestrians and drivers
- Congestion that blocks access for emergency vehicles

This situation is creating serious safety risks for children, parents, staff, and local residents. Visibility is often restricted, making it difficult for children to cross safely. Emergency vehicle access may also be compromised during peak times. Near misses have been witnessed, and there is growing concern that without intervention, a serious accident may occur.

We respectfully request that the Highways Department review the situation and consider appropriate measures to improve safety. Possible actions might include:

- Increased enforcement presence during peak school hours
- Installation of additional signage or road markings
- Introduction of school safety zones or timed restrictions
- Review of parking restrictions during school hours
- Traffic calming measures

- A review of existing parking regulations

I believe that proactive steps now will help protect children and improve safety for everyone in the community.

As a community, we would welcome the opportunity for a site visit during peak times so that the situation can be observed first-hand.

The safety of children and the wider community must be the priority, and we would greatly appreciate your support in addressing this matter as soon as possible.

I would appreciate confirmation that this matter is being reviewed and information about any proposed actions or timelines.
