## INTRODUCTION

There has been a great deal of emphasis on developing entrepreneurship in the country to promote first generation entrepreneurs. Realizing the effective role of entrepreneurship in the process of industrialization in the developed countries, India and others developing nations viewed this as an effective measure to develop entrepreneurship to promote national production, balanced regional development, and dispersal of economic power and provide better employment opportunities.

It is a pertinent fact that the youth contribute Forty percent (40%) of total population of India. Therefore, it is important to encourage youth to take up entrepreneurship as a career for the growth and development of the country.

However, developing entrepreneurs requires effort by way of counselling, guiding and supporting the prospective entrepreneurs in various stages starting from conceiving the project ideas to final implementation and successfully running of the micro enterprises. Entrepreneurial training has been found to be of special significance for helping potential entrepreneurs to establish and manage their enterprises successfully. Responding to the above, it become a urge of the day that entrepreneurship must be promoted.

The Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE), Government of India (GOI) has launched a World Bank loan assisted programme which is an outcome-oriented Pilot Project. Aims to implement the mandate of the National Skill Development Mission (NSDM). The project is being implemented in mission mode and is aligned with the overall objectives of the NSDM.

NIESBUD has been sanctioned Pilot Project for strengthening the entrepreneurship ecosystem to different sections of the society including marginalized population with the under the EDP Training Programmes of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE).

Under one of the activity in PILOT PROJECT sanctioned to NIESBUD the institute is conducting Entrepreneurship Development Programme for youths followed by mentoring and handholding to trainees who have strong desire to pursue entrepreneurial opportunities. The initiative targets 5000 youths in 10 states and envisages outcome in the form of establishment of Nano and Micro Enterprises as well as linking up participants with suitable wage employment.

The EDP being organized under PILOT PROJECT is spread over a period of 15 days and aims at imparting to the learners a thorough insight into the various aspects of enterprise

creation, technical know-how, credit sources, and marketing of products and changing trends of market in global scenario. The programme will make the participants to understand the concepts of identification/ selection of projects and setting up of own enterprise so as to run their business successfully. While the programme incorporates a thorough briefing on Government support systems, it also includes additional benefits of being an entrepreneur. The institute has organized Entrepreneurship Development Programme under PILOT PROJECT at Berhampur, Ganjam Odisha from 16.02.2023 to 03.03.2023

## **OBJECTIVES**

The objectives of the training programme were:

- To impart Knowledge on Entrepreneurship;
- To acquaint the participants about entrepreneurial opportunities;
- To make aware the participants about the entrepreneurial support ecosystem;

- To impart knowledge and skills to participants on essential elements required for preparation of project report;
- To impart knowledge on necessary managerial skills required to run the enterprise;
- To provide post-training assistance through Mentoring and handholding support.

The target group for the training programme comprised of unemployed/ drop outs of age group 18 to 50 Years willing to pursue entrepreneurship as a career option. A total number of 60 trainees participated in EDP.

The training programme was spread over a period of 15 days from 16.02.2023 to 03.03.2023.

## PROGRAMME REPORT ( SESSION -WISE )

<b>Day 1</b>	
<b>Micro Lab</b>	The training programme started with the scientifically designed micro lab to break the mental block and build self confidence amongst the participants. The session objective was to familiarize the participants with each other.
<b>Entrepreneur, Entrepreneurship and Enterprise</b>	The session objective was to introduce the concept of Entrepreneur, Entrepreneurship and Enterprise to the participants.
<b>Characteristics of an Entrepreneur</b>	The session objective was to upgrade the knowledge and skills of the participants on characteristics of an entrepreneur. The session was aimed to help the participants to understand the different characteristics through various behavioral exercises and case studies.
<b>Day 2</b>	
<b>Entrepreneurial Motivation</b>	Entrepreneurial Motivation was taken as first session on second day of the training programme. Entrepreneurship motivation is a practical laboratory consisting of scientifically design behavioral exercises where participant get an opportunity to analyze self through learning from feedback approach, and also get the opportunity to manage oneself. The behavioral exercises on entrepreneurial motivation in Individual and group motivates the participants to take up entrepreneurship as a career.
<b>Group Entrepreneurship &amp; Social Entrepreneurship : Prospects</b>	The session objective was to deliberate on the dimensions of entrepreneurship development with focus on group entrepreneurship and its role in economic development, empowerment, and social equality to the members. The session also imparted knowledge to participants on opportunities in the social entrepreneurship domain as an important

	aspect of social responsibility and a way to solve a variety of urgent societal problems.
<b>Day 3</b>	
<b>Life Skills &amp; Employability Skills</b>	The session objective was to upgrade the knowledge of the participants on life skills and employability skills. The session aimed to help the participants to understand the important role of life skills & employability skills for an entrepreneur in particular.
<b>Communication skills</b>	The session objective was to enable participants to communicate clearly and with impact, by improving their verbal and non-verbal communication style, as well as enhancing interpersonal skills.
<b>Interaction with successful entrepreneur</b>	<b>Mr. Srikant</b> who is successful entrepreneur. He shared experience of their entrepreneurial journey with the trainees along with the challenges faced by them and how they overcame the challenges and started the enterprise successfully.
<b>Business Opportunity Identification</b>	The session objective was to empower the trainees with the knowledge and skill which will help them to conceive business idea. This session helps the participant to upgrade their knowledge and skills on how to identify a viable business IDEA and transform it into an opportunity.
<b>Day 4</b>	
<b>Brainstorming Activity for Business Opportunity Identification</b>	Brainstorming activity was conducted to help participants generate and discuss their business ideas. The faculty guided the participants in selecting the business ideas.
<b>Overview of Market Survey; Market Survey: Tools &amp; Techniques &amp; Guidance for Field Work</b>	The session aimed to help the participants to understand the different methods of market survey for starting an enterprise. The session objective was to upgrade the knowledge and skills of the participants on concepts of marketing and market survey.
<b>Day 5</b>	
<b>Entrepreneurship Support Ecosystem</b>	The session objective was to upgrade the knowledge and skills of the participants on entrepreneurship support eco system. The session aimed to help the participants to understand the role of entrepreneurship support and enabling eco system for promoting entrepreneurship in the country.
<b>Entrepreneurship Schemes of State Govt : DIC</b>	<b>Mr. S Chiranjibi Patra</b> has taken the session on Entrepreneurship Schemes of State Govt : DIC

<b>Start up and Incubation</b>	The session aimed to acquaint participants with the collaborative programmes for startups designed to help them in their infancy succeed by providing workspace, seed funding, mentoring, handholding and training.
<b>Emotional Intelligence for Entrepreneurial Success</b>	Positive emotional intelligence can increase innovativeness that may lead to entrepreneurial success. The session aimed to make participants understand the role of emotional intelligence in activating entrepreneurs' innovativeness.
<b>Day 6 &amp; 7</b>	
<b>Field Activity :Market Survey</b>	The participants went for market survey with regard to their business ideas in the nearby vicinities to collect the information needed for starting the enterprises, understanding the demand and supply chain of the target market, Developing marketing plans, Figure out customer expectations/ needs and build their business plans.
<b>Day 8</b>	
<b>Presentation of Participants on Market Survey</b>	The participants presented their individual findings based on the market survey undertaken by them.
<b>Marketing Management</b>	The session aimed to make the participants understand the concepts of marketing management, learn about marketing process for different types of products and services, understand the tools used by entrepreneurs in decision situations and to better to understand the marketing environment.
<b>Digital Marketing and Usage of Social Media for Marketing and Communication</b>	The session objective was to provide participants with a background into digital marketing, and discuss how to use digital marketing for engaging audiences and its risks. It also distinguished between traditional marketing and digital marketing, digital marketing platforms, segmentation strategies and the digital marketing plan. The session aimed to make participants familiar with social media platforms, basic fundamentals for setting their personal and business accounts, understand basic social media etiquette, create a social media strategy, publish social media updates and engage with a community, apply social media best practices to enhance their personal brand, and understand social media advertising.
<b>Day 9</b>	
<b>Types of Enterprises</b>	The session objective was to upgrade the knowledge and skills of the participants on types of enterprises.

	The session aimed to help participants understand different types of legal entity which may be formed for running and starting an enterprise.
<b>Entrepreneurial Accounting</b>	The session provided a broad base coverage of issues related to accounting, such as: basic accounting concepts & their applications to businesses, capital raising, short-term & long-term financial planning, accounting principles & concepts, relevant to (future) business owners and entrepreneurs.
<b>Entrepreneurial Taxation</b>	The session aimed to familiarize participants with the tax system as applicable to the entrepreneurs in particular. It provided trainees with a working knowledge of the fundamental tax principles and rules.
<b>Procedure and Formalities for Bank Finance</b>	The session objective was to upgrade the knowledge and skills of the participants on procedure and formalities for bank finance as well as preparation of Business Plan. The session aimed to help participants in gaining knowledge on step-by-step procedure and formalities which are required for seeking loan from the banks or financial organization. The session also aimed to help participants to understand different components of business plan and the methodology for its preparation.
<b>Day 10</b>	
<b>Preparation of Business Plan</b>	The session aimed to help participants to understand different components of business plan and the methodology for its preparation.
<b>Day 11</b>	
<b>Presentation on Business Plan by participants</b>	The participants presented the business plans prepared by them which were evaluated by the faculty. The participants were further assisted in making their business plans viable and bankable by the faculty.
<b>Day 12</b>	
<b>Procedure and Formality for Online Application for Financial Linkage under different schemes</b>	The participants were familiarized with the procedure and formalities for submission of online application for obtaining financial assistance under different schemes of the Government and Financial institutions.
<b>Interaction with Bank Official</b>	<b>Mr. Niranjan Mahanty Retired AGM Union bank of India</b> interacted with the participants and made them aware about the schemes especially for the women and reserved category who want to start their own business.



<b>IPR AndIts Management, Pattern, Copy Rights, Trade Mark and Industrial Management</b>	The session aimed to introduce fundamental aspects of Intellectual property Right to participants, disseminate knowledge on patents, patent regime in India and registration aspects, disseminate knowledge on copyrights and its related rights and registration aspects, knowledge on trademarks Design, Geographical Indication (GI), and create awareness about current trends in IPR and Govt. steps in fostering IPR.
<b>Entrepreneurial Leaders</b>	The session aimed to introduce the concept of Entrepreneurial leadership as a mindset that focuses organizations on turning problems into opportunities that create economic and social value. The participants were also familiarized with notable entrepreneurial leasers in the society.
<b>Day 13</b>	
<b>Enterprise Management</b>	The session aimed to help the participants to understand the different steps of enterprise management which helps to manage vital day-to-day processes such as inventory management, accounting, human resources and customer relationship management.
<b>Regulatory Compliances and Registration for Enterprises</b>	The participants were made aware about the different regulatory and legal compliances needed for starting enterprises in different sectors. The participants were also made familiar with the process of obtaining different registrations and compliances through online portals.

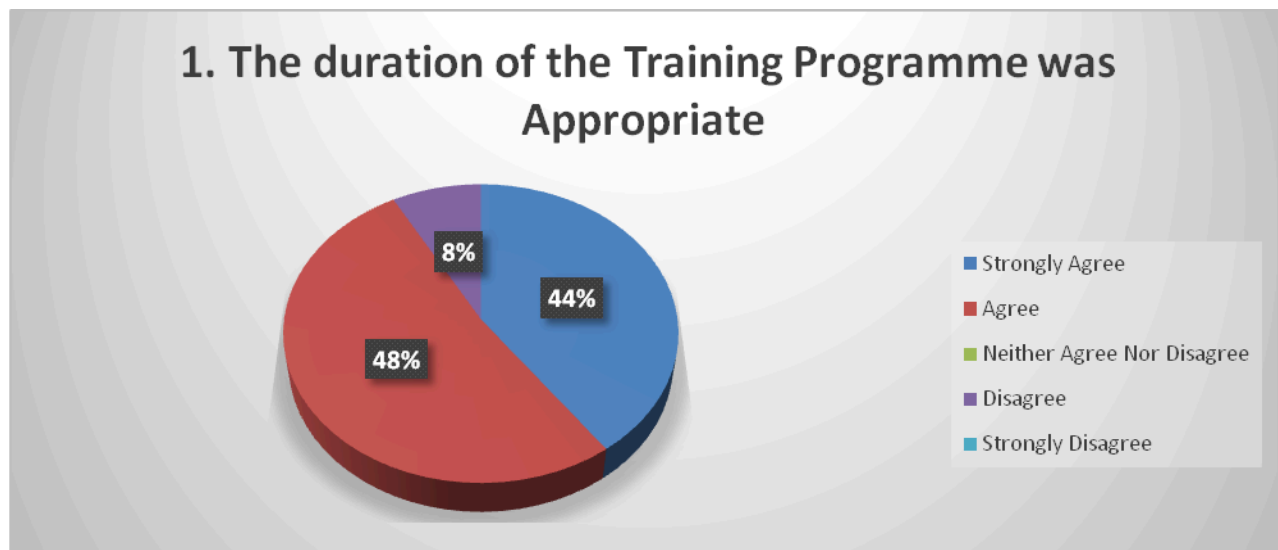

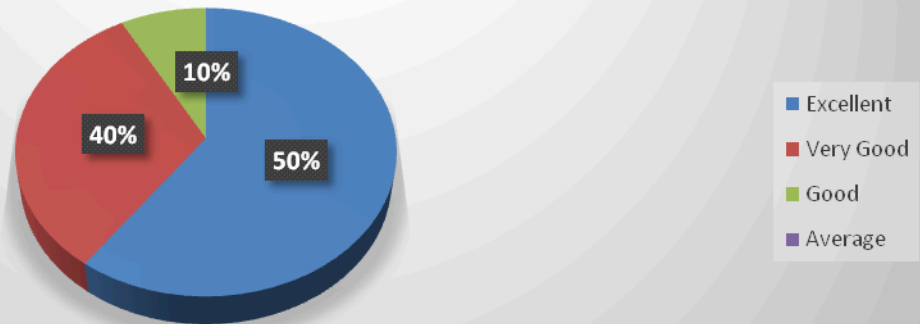

**5. Rate the Program Coordinator in terms of organizing the training program**



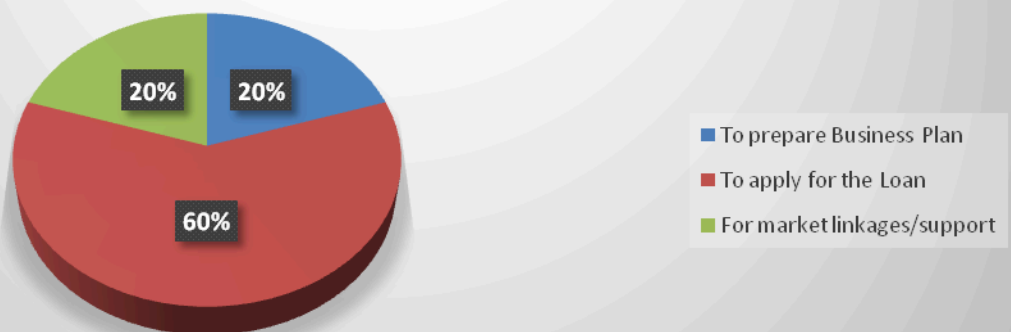
6. Are you already engaged in some informal business activity?
