The AP Program is accelerating its transition to digital testing. Starting in May 2025, standard paper testing will be discontinued for 28 AP Exams—these exams will move to the Bluebook digital testing application.

Fully Digital Subjects: Students complete multiple-choice and free-response questions in Bluebook, with all responses automatically submitted at the end of the exam.

Hybrid Digital Subjects: Students complete multiple-choice questions and view free-response questions in Bluebook. They handwrite their free-response answers in paper exam booklets that are returned for scoring.

AP exam locations will be communicated to students at least a week in advance, including alternate testing locations due to CollegeBoard-approved accommodations.

Depending on the AP exam subject, *standard time* exams will range between 2-4 hours in length. This means that afternoon tests could go as late as 4:00 PM (or later for students with extended time accommodations).

Students need to arrive in their testing location no later than 7:45 am for the morning session and 11:45 am for the afternoon session. Attendance and punctuality are very important.

Students will need to bring their charged school-issued Chromebooks and chargers. Students will need to make sure they know their College Board login information before the exam. This is how they will access the test. WSH does not have this information. Students should bring pencils, a black or blue pen, and a calculator (if needed). Cell phones and smart watches are strictly prohibited. Please do not bring them into your testing location.

All AP Students should have received communication from CollegeBoard regarding the 2025 AP Exam Terms and Conditions. These are now available to review at [cb.org/apexamterms](https://collegeboard.org/apexamterms).

- **All AP students will need to accept these terms and conditions prior to taking their AP Exam(s)**

- Any updates to the terms and conditions will be summarized on the terms and conditions page.
- CollegeBoard will send all AP students email reminders to review these terms and conditions before the exam administration.

Note: *For AP Art and Design, students need to agree to the Digital Portfolio AP Exam Terms and Conditions before submitting their work as final in the AP Digital Portfolio.*

AP teachers will communicate post-AP exam attendance expectations. Just a reminder that WSH's Closed Campus rules will still apply. Students are not allowed to leave campus in the middle of the school day. However, they are welcome to come to campus late or leave early if their AP class has an independent work day. All 9th/10th-grade students in an AP class should plan to report to their AP classroom every day after the exam.
