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Abstract

*The abstract should be clear and concise, summarizing the essence of the paper. It must consist of a single paragraph with single spacing, containing 150–175 words, and include 3 to 5 keywords. The abstract should not contain citations (references). A research-based abstract must include the research problem and/or objectives, methodology or approach, and research findings. The abstract should be typed in **Cambria, font size 10.***

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INTRODUCTION

The introduction should include the background, research problem, a review of previous literature (state of the art) as a basis for the novelty of the article, and the research objectives.

The manuscript should be typed using **Cambria font, size 12, with 1.5 spacing** (except for the abstract and reference list, which use single spacing). Margins should follow the standard format (all sides: 2.54 cm). The total word count for the manuscript should be between **4,000–5,000 words**.

LITERATURE

This section provides a review of the literature, explaining the theories and concepts used in the study.

METHODOLOGY

This section describes the methodology used to address the research problem and the data analysis techniques employed to achieve the research objectives.

DISCUSSION

This section presents research findings, supported by sufficient data and literature, and comprehensively

discusses them. The discussion should address the research problem or hypothesis mentioned in the introduction.

Tables and figures (if any) must be titled and clearly labeled below the table/figure. The entire manuscript, including tables and figures, should be in **monochrome (black and white)**. For **OJS (Online Journal System)**, tables and figures may be in full color (RGB format) or monochrome, with a resolution of **300 dpi** in **JPG/TIFF format**. The maximum **full-page width is 70 mm**, and the maximum length is **one page**. Tables and figures should be in **portrait orientation, not landscape**.

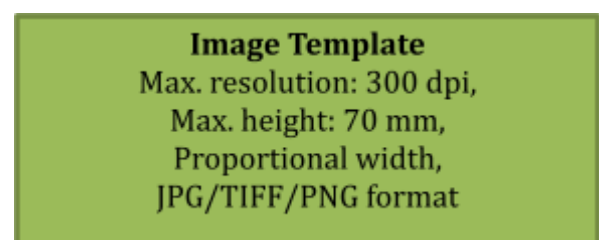


Figure 1. Natural Disaster

The reference list should only include sources that are explicitly cited in the article. Conversely, all sources cited in the article must appear in the reference list. The reference list is placed at the **end of the article (not on a new page)**. At least **80% of the references should be primary and recent sources (published within the last 10 years)**.
