What: Getting community candidates in primaries and elections across Virginia in 2025.

Why: To get our voices and issues in campaigns, shift discussions and narrative, and exemplify a grassroots democratic process - ahead of **2026 MIDTERM ELECTIONS.**

How: A model like <u>democratic confederalism</u> from Rojava:

We ask community members - from apartment buildings, local orgs, neighborhoods - to nominate candidates for a given election (e.g. Governor, Attorney General, City Council)

For those who accept nominations:

1. We hold a vote among participant communities to determine which candidates we want to put forward in certain races. For state-wide races (e.g. Governor), we would field nominations and hold votes with communities across the state.

Nominees not chosen may be ideal for other seats – Local Council, VA Delegate

- Start preparing filing for candidates.
 - a. For state-wide elections (Gov, Lt Gov, Attorney General), candidates need 15,000 petition signatures w/ at least 600 from each district by APRIL 3RD

The filing deadline for city council races with party primaries (e.g. Alexandra, Charlottesville, Manassas) is also APRIL 3RD Other Requirements 1 WITHIN 10 DAYS of

accepting a contribution, spending any funds, paying a filing fee, filing a candidate statement of qualification, or appointing a campaign treasurer, committee

MUST FILE STATEMENT OF ORGANIZATION (!!!)

- 2. <u>Campaign Finance Reporting</u> (Recurring) Reports due April 15th, June 9th, July 15th, September 15th ...
- 3. Pay filing fee for candidate. (Governor = \$3,500, Lt Gov = \$726.42, A.G. = \$3,000)
- **4. Qualifications:** State-wide: 30+ at time of election, Virginia resident for last 5 years House of Delegates: 21+ at time of election, Virginia resident for last 1 year
