### **1. Financial Cancer Care (FCC)**

A \$250 stipend is offered to participants in the workshop, and another \$250 is available when the Pro Bono Certified Financial Planner's appointments with the participants are over. To ensure patients receive practical aid alongside their cancer treatment, our comprehensive support system strives to ease the weight of financial toxicity that often accompanies cancer care.

### **Eligibility Requirements for Financial Cancer Care (FCC)**

The following conditions must be satisfied before you may enroll in Financial Cancer Care

**For patients or family members to register for the FCC Workshop:**

- The patient must be at least 18 years old.
- We serve 14 counties in Minnesota and Wisconsin: Anoka, Carver, Chisago, Dakota, Hennepin, Isanti, Olmsted, Ramsey, Scott, Sherburne, St. Louis, Washington, Wright, and St. Croix.
- Within the previous two years, the patient had undergone cancer therapy.

**For a private consultation with an accredited financial planner**

- Participant satisfies all requirements for the Financial Cancer Care Workshop.
- The patient is handling their own finances.
- The patient does not have a financial planner on retainer at this time.

## **2. Adult & Family Programs (AFP)**

Helping people and their families cope with life after a cancer diagnosis is the mission of **Angel Foundation's Adult & Family Programs (AFP)**. Making Memories provides a way for families that are struggling financially because of treatment costs to still spend meaningful time together through virtual and in-person activities. Free activities, such as going to a sporting event or a theatrical performance, bring people together and make them happy. At the same time, Angel Packs are crucial resources for parents to help their children understand cancer in a way that is both soothing and suitable for their age. Patients in specific service regions have access to these tools, helping ease the mental and emotional toll of a cancer diagnosis. Adults with cancer have access to a number of grant programs that go beyond Angel Foundation.

- Everyone impacted by a cancer diagnosis, from those undergoing treatment to those who have overcome the disease.
- Anoka, Carver, Chisago, Dakota, Hennepin, Isanti, Olmsted, Ramsey, Scott, Sherburne, St. Croix (WI), St. Louis, Washington, or Wright Counties are designated areas of care for families.
- Participants in the Angel Packs™ program are looking for ways to help kids who are learning about cancer.
- Those who are keen on taking advantage of the educational opportunities and special Making Memories activities.
- Angel Pack applications require cancer clinics to fill out a Medical Information Form.
- Based on individual circumstances and available resources, grant programs may have unique qualifying conditions.

### 3. Emergency Financial Assistance (EFA)

To alleviate pressing financial worries, the **Emergency Financial Assistance program offers grants for non-medical needs**. There is a wide variety of non-medical costs that these subsidies can cover, including but not limited to: housing, utilities, phone, transportation, groceries, petrol, and maintenance on any vehicle. #### **Eligibility Requirements for Emergency Financial Assistance (EFA)**

The foundation's **Emergency Financial Assistance Program has the following general requirements**. Everybody needs to

- Have reached the age of eighteen.
- Require ongoing cancer treatment, such as a bone marrow transplant, chemotherapy, hormone therapy, clinical trials, hospice care, immunotherapy, palliative care, radiation, or surgery requiring more than four weeks for recuperation.

- Comply with the Angel Foundation™'s specified financial requirements.
- Have never before been granted monetary aid by our organization. These distributions are offered only once in a person's lifetime.
- Currently reside in or get treatment inside one of the following Minnesota or Wisconsin counties: Anoka, Carver, Chisago, Dakota, Hennepin, Isanti, Olmsted, Ramsey, Scott, Sherburne, St. Louis, Washington, or Wright.

## Angel Foundation Grant Program Eligibility

Eligibility requirements could differ because there are probably several Angel Foundations that provide grant programs. Here are some broad qualifying criteria you may face, though, derived from the examples provided.

- Have a medical diagnosis, most often cancer.
- Keep up with your medical therapy. Treatment options may involve radiation, chemotherapy, or surgery, all of which require significant time for recuperation.

- Reside in one of the designated areas covered by the foundation's work.

It has provided financial assistance to researchers who contributed valuable research on treating cancers in order to community welfare. **Angel Foundation grants for cancer treatment** are recognized by knowing its grantees from a number of renowned institutes.

### **Scott A. Armstrong**

Epigenetic processes in MLL-rearranged leukemias are the subject of ground-breaking research by Scott A. Armstrong, MD, PhD, of Children's Hospital and Dana Farber Cancer Institute. The goal of Armstrong's group is to find new treatment targets, especially histone methyltransferases, in acute myelogenous leukemia (AML) by using high-throughput methods to evaluate gene activity and chromosomal structure. With the help of Gabrielle's Angel Foundation, important research into histone methylation may continue, opening new possibilities for AML therapy and maybe leading to better results and better drugs.

### **Arnob Banerjee**

Peripheral T Cell Lymphoma (PTCL) is an area of study for Arnob Banerjee, MD, PhD, of the University of Maryland School of Medicine. The goal of Banerjee's research, drawing from genomics and molecular biology, is to identify the mutations and gene regulatory disturbances that are responsible for the cancerous nature of PTCL. There is an immediate need for additional effective treatments in this condition with a bad prognosis, and our research will help fill that need by providing new ways of treating PTCL patients.

### **Jennifer Amengual**

Therapeutic targets in diffuse large B-cell lymphoma (DLBCL) are the focus of research of Dr. Jennifer Amengual of the New York University Cancer Institute. Investigating the possibility that Histone Deacetylase Inhibitors (HDACIs) might alter these proteins, leading to the death of cancer cells, her study dives into the BCL6:p53 axis, pivotal in the pathogenesis of DLBCL. Amengual's research shows promise for improving DLBCL patient outcomes and quality of life through the development of novel therapy options that can supplement current standard care.

### **Juliet N. Barker**

An expert in hematopoietic malignancies, Juliet N. Barker, MBBS (Hons), FRACP, works at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center to improve the use of UCB grafts in the treatment of high-risk cases. For the purpose of overcoming the limits of inadequate cell counts in single unit UCB transplants, especially in adults, Barker's study combines UCB samples from two separate newborns. There is an urgent need for successful transplant choices for individuals with leukemia and myelodysplasia, and this novel technique may help meet that demand by increasing their access to curative therapy.

Get the Financial Assistance Application by downloading it or filling it out online. Be careful and complete it completely.

### **Send in Patient Health Document**

One of the most important parts of applying is filling out the medical information form.

Everyone in the family feels the effects of a parent's cancer diagnosis in the Adult & Family Programs. All members of the family can find support from our in-person programming, consultations, and online resources as they navigate the cancer journey.

### **Can you get an Angel Foundation grant for medication?**

Yes, Angel Foundation funding may, in fact, pay for cancer patients' medicine expenditures. Grants from the Emergency Financial Assistance program can help with non-medical costs associated with cancer treatment, such as prescription drugs.

### **What support do we offer children, preteens, and teens?**

Camp Angel, medical play sessions, and family retreats are some of the programs and activities that teach children about cancer in an age-appropriate and evidence-based way. The children involved in these activities have a better understanding of how cancer is different from other illnesses, that their actions and words did not cause their parents' cancer, and that

**Who qualifies for Adult & Family Programs?**

Families in Minnesota who are dealing with a cancer diagnosis in one or more members of the family are eligible to participate in the Adult & Family Programs. No one pays to participate in the program, even if they don't qualify for the Angel Foundation's<sup>TM</sup> Emergency Financial Assistance program.

**Does the Angel Foundation help with transportation costs?**

Yes,As a part of their Emergency Financial Assistance program, Angel Foundation does, in fact, help with transportation expenses. To assist pay for things like petrol or public transportation, cancer patients can use their grants to cover non-medical costs so they can get to their treatment appointments and other services.
