

Inclusive Inquiry Cycle

The *Inclusive Inquiry Cycle* is a tool developed by Start Early (formerly known as Ounce of Prevention Fund) as part of their Essential Fellowship professional development program. This tool guides programs through a process of gathering information, reflecting together to identify key questions and making plans for continuous quality improvement. In Oregon, local CCR&Rs have Quality Improvement Staff on site who can help you move through an Inclusive Inquiry Cycle. The steps are as follows:

1. Analyze Data
2. Identify Key Issues and Questions
3. Set Learning and Improvement Goals
4. Investigate Resources
5. Develop and Tune Action Plan
6. Implement Plan and Collect Data
