### **Discussion Questions:** Observation and Interpretation

For the leaders: Main Idea of Colossians 2:1-7 = Stay in the Truth

- Review the context

#### Read Colossians 2:1-7 in 2-3 different translations

- 1. What questions do you have?
- 2. What does Paul mean when he says he's struggled greatly on their behalf (v.1)? Why would he do that?
  - a. For the Leaders: he wrote to them and taught them, prayed constantly for them. Because the bond of Christ within us is stronger even than blood
- 3. What was Paul struggling for these believers to achieve according to v. 2?
- 4. What does it mean to have "full assurance of understanding"? (v.2)
- 5. How does Paul demonstrate the idea of Christian unity in vv. 1-5?
- 6. According to v. 4, why does he want believers to grow and mature?
- 7. Why does Paul take time to say that he is "rejoicing to see your good order and the firmness of your faith in Christ"?
  - a. <u>For the Leaders</u>: think about the reasons we need to be reminded that we are "Saints" from the book we read :)
- 8. After receiving Christ, what are 2 actions believers should take according to vv. 6-7? What does that look like?
  - a. For the Leaders: Walk in Christ, Abound in thanksgiving
- 9. How can we be "rooted" and "built up" in Jesus and "established in our faith"? Is there any difference between those three?
  - a. <u>For the Leaders</u>: Spiritual maturity develops from the foundation of biblical truth and sound doctrine.
- 10. <u>Group Application</u>: What is the practical implication of being established in Christ for daily life? What are some ways that good discipline and stability of faith are displayed in the Christian life?

## **Application Questions:**

- 1. Spend some time encouraging each person in the ways that you see them reflecting Jesus. Where can you catch even a "whiff of the aroma of Christ"?
- 2. What are the false gospels that you are tempted to believe? (ie Jesus+something, seeking comfort, security, peace, love, identity in something or someone other than Jesus.)
  - a. Where are you finding value, significance and identity?! (Where you are rooted in Christ or in other things?)
- 3. Are there any lies you are believing about yourself or God that need to be brought into the light?
