I am writing to you to urge you to **go on the record** and state that you will not confirm any Supreme Court Justice Nominees during the 2020 Election. In 2016, Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell declared any appointment by the sitting president to be null and void. He said the next Supreme Court justice should be chosen by the next president — to be elected later that year. The 11 Republican members of the Senate Judiciary Committee signed a letter saying they had no intention of consenting to any nominee from Obama. No proceedings of any kind were held on the nominee in 2016.

We are asking that you honor the precedent set by yourself and members of your own party. Do not confirm any nominees by the current president. Let the winner of the November 3rd presidential election select the nominee to replace Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg.
