PR (Reg) Seager – Life Member 1951, was a Hobart solicitor who had been associated with table tennis since the Ping Pong craze that swept Hobart at the turn of the 20th century. An initial North vs South in 1902 event saw Reg win the Championship match. He continued as a leading pre-war player in Hobart after restarting the sport in the mid 1930's.

He was first president of the Tasmanian Association which adopted its constitution in 1936. He was Tas President from 1936-1941 and 1948-1957.

He was the organiser of a successful tour by World champion players Michael Szabados and Steven Kelen in 1937. The tour which included Hobart, Launceston and Burnie lifted the profile of the sport and had a great impact on the playing style of local players.

At the 1951 AGM he was elected first Life Member of the Tasmanian Association and was Patron for many years.
