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Meeting Notes/Summary

Caregiver Themes:

Amanda walked the group through the preliminary findings and raw data. Group reflections were shared. Many folks stated the effect of isolation and as we look toward re-opening, it will be important to offer choices in how caregivers can engage with others at trusted community places, like the Family Room, CVHS, Lund, etc. The full raw data can be found here: [BBF SUD Caregiver Survey Raw Data](#). We will take a deeper look at the themes later this summer, when we start to develop strategies for our final year of funding (we hope!).

Next steps: Amanda to work on inviting a parent to attend next month's meeting. This data will also be an important part of the final report we hope to publish about this project in 2022.

Communication Tool Update:

Development is underway, we will be testing it out at the upcoming community training in mid June. Amanda will move it to our shared project site and we can figure out next steps (ie: how to disseminate this information) at a future meeting.

SUD Training:

Molly and Amanda are recruiting for the upcoming training on 6/16. The hope is to offer the training as a pilot of sorts, so we can enhance it as we go. We talked about using the chat function to capture what folks want to learn, pause after the data section to inquire about what other data they would want to see, and then have a debrief at the end of the training. Amanda will share feedback with Renee Kelley and check in to see if other teams across the state have had success yet with the training.

Updates:

We talked about missing voices and came up with the following list of folks we'd like to develop stronger links to: AALV, DCF Family Services, COGS, Postpartum Providers/Pediatrics, Community Health Teams.
