

HOUSING NOW FOR HOMELESS FAMILIES

The Housing Now for Homeless Families Program offers grants to local nonprofits that provide temporary financial assistance and supportive services to rehouse families with children that are homeless or at-risk of homelessness. HNHF grants are administered by COHHIO and funded by federal Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) funding provided by the State of Ohio.

Eligible Clients

- Be homeless or at imminent risk of homelessness or fleeing/attempting to flee domestic violence
- Have custody of at least one minor child or be a single parent at least six months pregnant
- Be eligible for TANF assistance in Ohio, meaning income is below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines
- Be identified and prioritized for assistance through the local CoC's Coordinated Entry (CE) system or other defined local process

The HNHF grantees are listed in the table to the right along with their identified service areas. In some cases, the HNHF grantee has identified sub-grantee agencies to assist in program administration. Families experiencing homelessness or housing crises should contact the local homeless system access point for their county. These access points can be found at [HNHF Referral Access Points](#)
