I. Welcome & Introductions

- Welcomed existing and returning members.
- Introduced President-Elect Cheri Pierce to the council.

II. Budget Report

- Reviewed current fiscal year budgets alongside a comparative summary of ending balances from the prior school year.

III. Before & After School Clubs & Funding Allocation

- Reviewed program details and operational costs for club offerings, noting Title I funds cover the majority of expenses.
- **Action Item / Vote:** Motion made to approve an expenditure not to exceed \$5,000 from the General Tax Credit fund to fund remaining club facilitator positions.
 - **Result:** Unanimously approved.

IV. Council Vacancies & Recruitment

- Identified current openings: three certified staff positions and two parent representative positions.
- Confirmed recruitment outreach is active via a certified staff interest survey and a link in the September community newsletter.

V. Bylaws Review

- Reviewed existing bylaws and noted recommended language amendments for clarity and precision.

VI. Goal Alignment

- **Dr. Michael reviewed the campus goals established at the end of the prior school year.**
- **Council consensus prioritized immediate support for before- and after-school club sustainability and continued funding assistance for student field trips.**

VII. Principal's Campus Update

- **Enrollment: Current enrollment is 860 students, showing standard leveling after the first few weeks.**
- **Staffing: Additional staff positions were allocated to accommodate enrollment growth.**
- **Operations: School operations and student conduct are progressing smoothly despite overall growth, with high-volume routines such as lunch periods functioning effectively.**
