In this event, the server is preconfigured according to the topics included in this document. 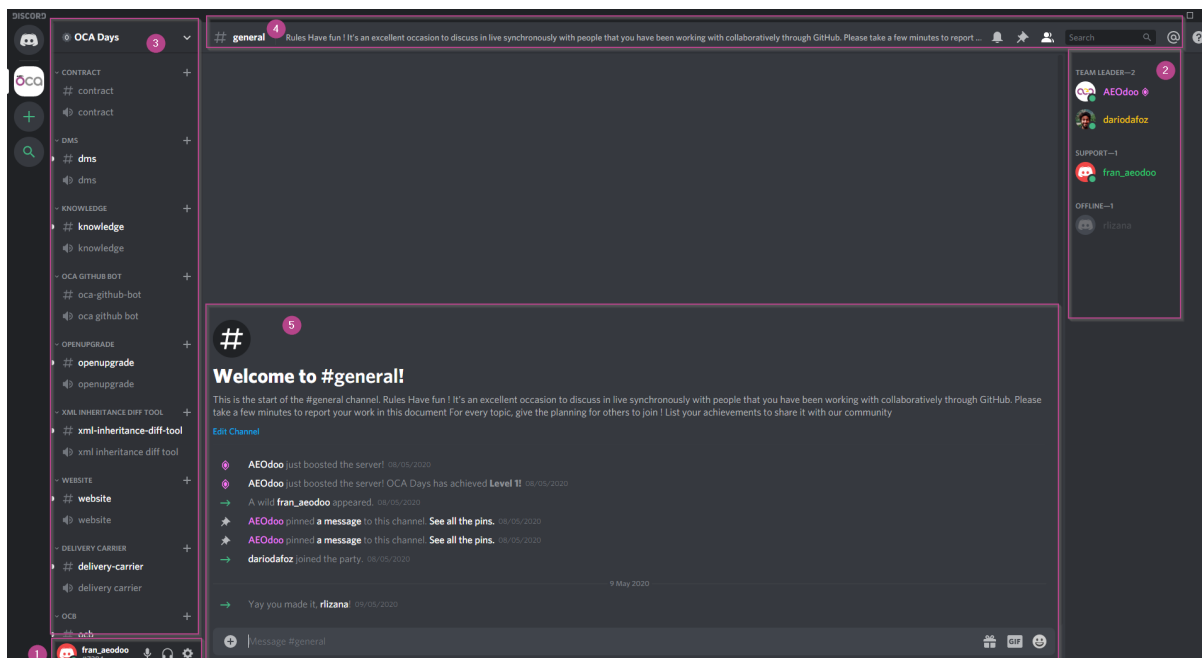
Steps to participate in this event.

2. If you do not have a Discord user account, you must create it.

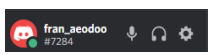
How we will use Discord during the event.

We review the main sections of Discord.

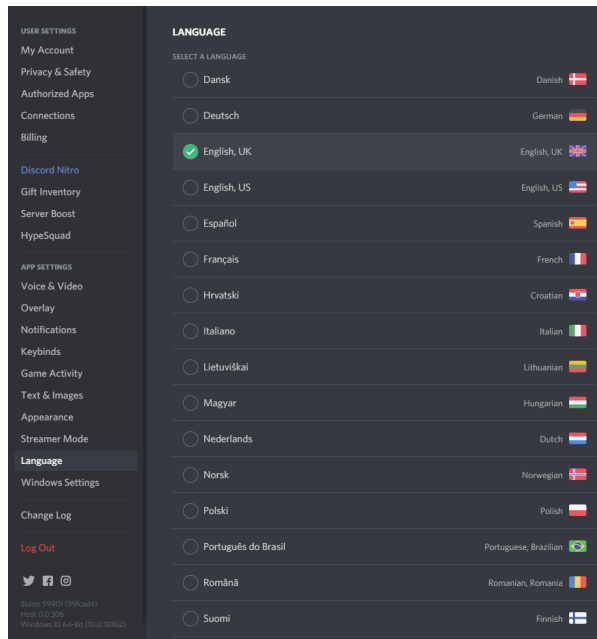
1. **User account:** In the user area we can configure our account.
2. **Server users list:** This section shows the users and the different roles of the users.
3. **Channels:** It shows the active channels that correspond to each of the topics of the event. And various information channels.
4. **Channel Info:** Details the information and options of the channel.
5. **Channel Tools:** Shows the tools depending on whether it is a voice or text channel.



User account

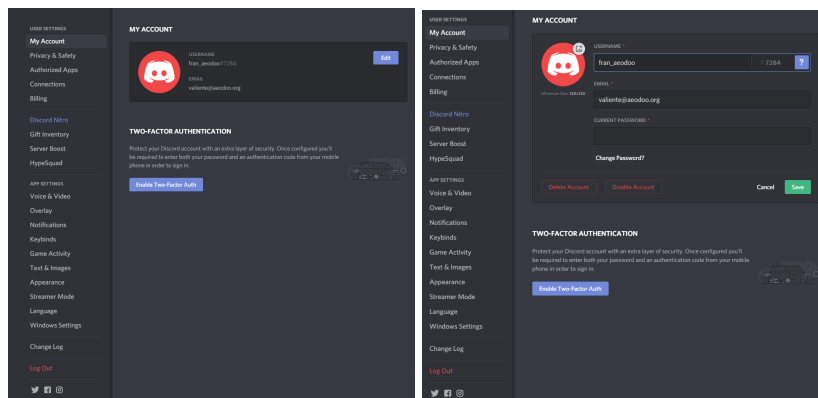
In the gear icon of the user area  we are going to configure:

- **Language:** you can configure Discord under your preferred language. Remember that the event will be in English except for the topic of Spanish localization.

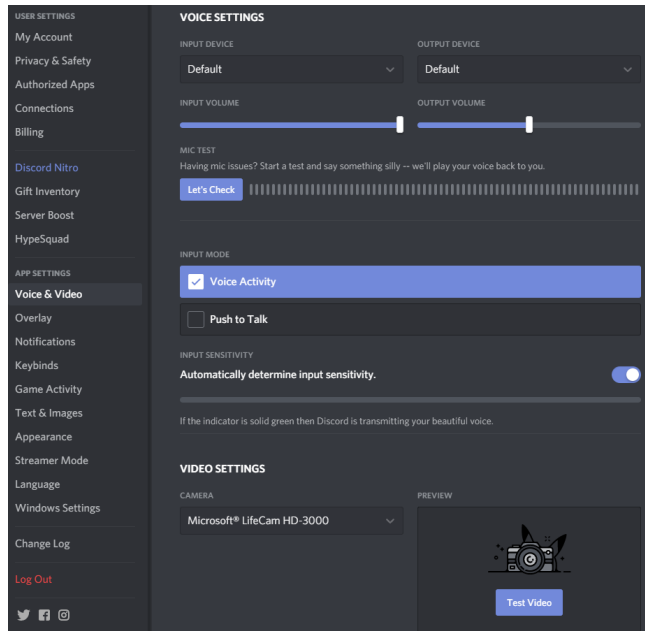


- **My Account:** Now we will configure our username so that we are identifiable by other users. You can change your avatar. Please follow this convention for the user name:

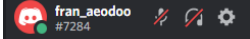

- **Voice & Video:** Configure your audio and video settings.



Your discord account has many more configuration options. But for the event we will only use the basic options.

The account area have two more icons . There are two buttons to mute/unmute the mic and earphones.

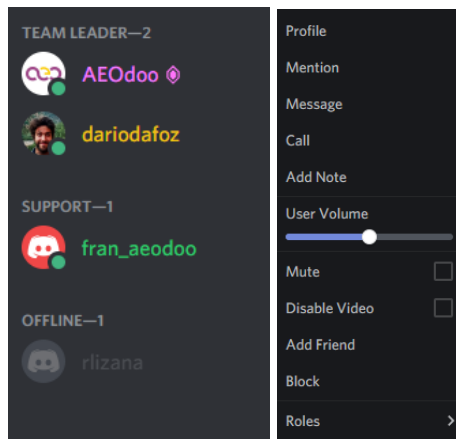
Server users list

The server member listing categorizes users into three roles and show the connection status of the users.

We detail each of the roles.

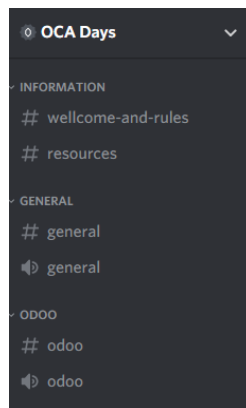
- Support: These users will provide help on the event and Discord settings. You can contact them by direct message. You can identify them because their name is green.
- Team leader: They are the leaders of the work teams. They can provide you with technical information. Each topic has one or more leaders. You can check in the channel information who is(are) their leader(s). Leaders can open new topics if requested. You can identify them because their name is yellow.
- Users: The rest of those attending the event will have the role of user.

If we click on the user with the right mouse button, the communication options are displayed.



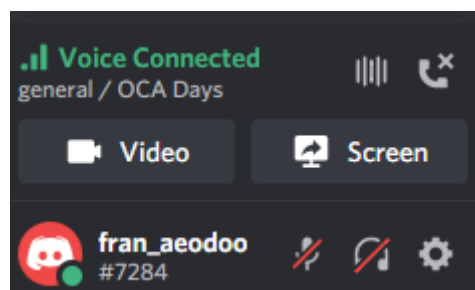
Channels

A channel is a means of communication of the text or voice and video type. Text channels are represented with a #. Audio and video channels are represented with a speaker icon. To access a channel, simply click on the channel.

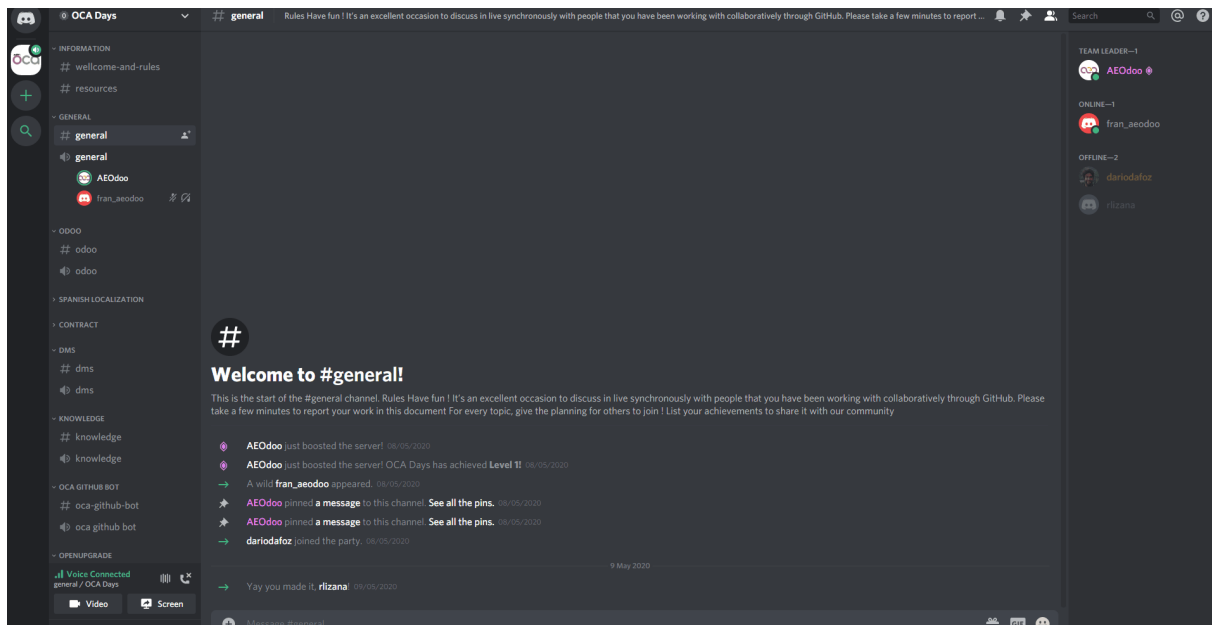


Text channels allow written communication and the sending of attached files.

Voice/Video channels allow voice calls, video calls and presentations through a shared screen. When we access a Voice/Video channel, the video and screen options will appear in my account area.



***Note: It is important to deactivate the notifications or mute on the channels in which we do not want to participate.**



If we rely on the content of the channel. In this event there are three types of channels.

Fixed type channels with which the user cannot interact, such as the welcome channel and event rules #welcome-and-rules and the resource channel #resources.

The #welcome-and-rules channel welcomes the user to the event and shows the event rules.

The #resources channel provides information on necessary resources during the event.

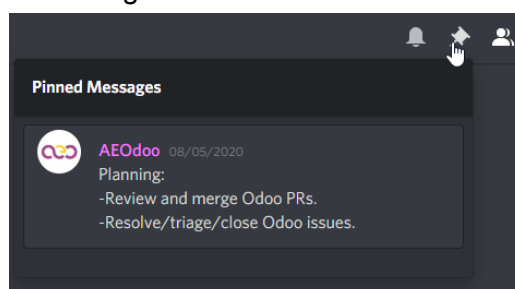
Generals type channels. Two channels, one of voice/video and the other of text for presentations or general talks.

Topics type channel. These channels are specific to develop the topics included in this document. You can suggest new topics to a team leader or in the #general channel.

When we access a text channel, it will show us fixed information about it in **channel info area**. In the topic channels we will have information about the work repository.

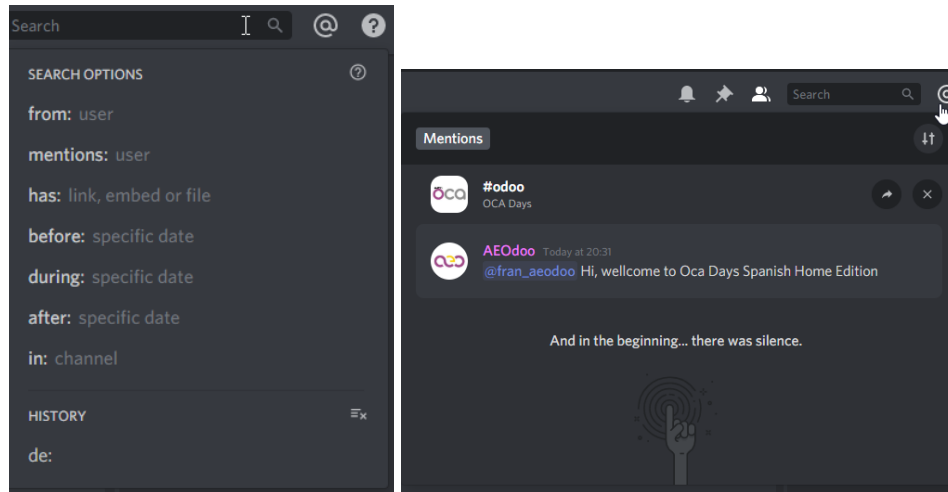


In the pin icon, the most important messages will be collected.



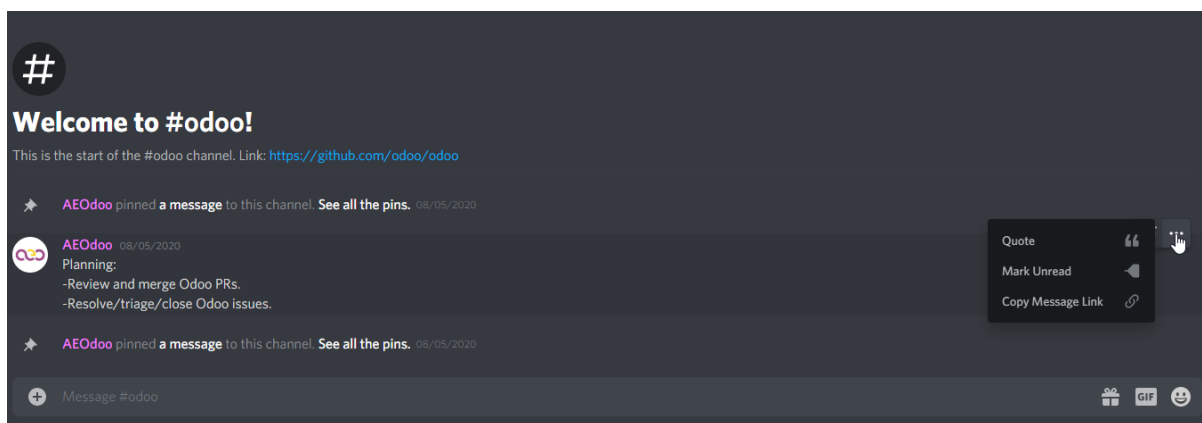
Discord has several search options on its text channels so you can find messages quickly.

Beside the search are the mentions. These notifications are very useful to check if another user has mentioned you in any of the active channels.

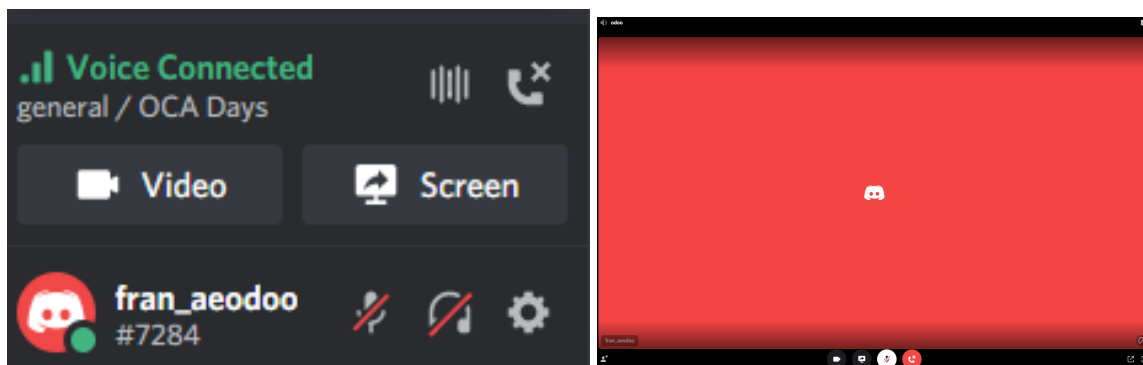


Discord chat works like any chat and they allow us to respond to other messages by clicking on the message.

We can send any type of file smaller than 50Mb. To attach a file we must press the icon plus.



When we access a voice / video channel, the webcam and shared screen options will be displayed.

- Assets: On the removal wizard, when selling assets, don't show both gain and loss accounts. Only the one that corresponds. Better yet: do the removal automatically when linking the asset on the sales invoice.
- On trial balance / general ledger, when clicking in the undistributed profits account (for example, 129 in Spain), list all the journal items that are included in this computation, including those from other accounts. Right now, only the items for this account are shown, confusing users.
