- STEM@SVSU is happy to announce that registration is now open for SMEKplus Summer Camps! SMEKplus Junior (ages 7 – 10): July 8 - 10, 2025 and SMEKplus Senior (ages 11 – 14): July 22 - 24, 2025. The Science and Mathematics Extravaganza for Kids (SMEKplus) summer camps involve area students, ages 7 - 14, in engaging, age-appropriate science, technology, engineering and mathematics enrichment activities. SMEK has been offered here at SVSU for over 25 years. Past activities include building a trebuchet, engineering bubble wands, studying organisms from our very own wetlands, LEGO robotics, constructing a mini golf course and more! Students participating in this 3-day camp will experience hands-on, project-based lessons taught by area certified teachers and assisted by SVSU undergraduates aspiring to become teachers, as well as enjoy lunch in the Marketplace at Doan. Registration deadline is June 7, 2025, but seats are limited for each camp, so register early! Early Bird Registration through March 31, 2025, save \$5! Regular prices of \$150 resume April 1, 2025. There are limited scholarships available to assist with the cost of attending SMEKplus Camps.
