It's The Big Short meets Corner Gas meets That '70s Show — a cross-border buddy comedy of economic idiocy.

The Idiots

Ashton Kutcher as Michael Kelso – A former pretty-boy trying to reinvent himself as a "financial influencer." Thinks "shorting a stock" means wearing cargo shorts. Fred Ewanuick as Hank Yarbo – Still jobless, still proud, now convinced he's "the Canadian Wolf of Wall Street." His office is the gas-station parking lot.

They meet on Reddit's r/GetRichEh and, through a series of typos and misunderstandings, launch a short squeeze on a worthless Canadian lithium company.

Suddenly they're the faces of a populist uprising they don't understand.

Spade: "You can't arrest innovation, man—unless it's trending." Kurtwood: "I can sure as hell try, Duntley."

He teaches Kelso and Hank just enough tech-bro nonsense to blow up two markets and half of North America's bandwidth.



Kurtwood Smith as Agent Red Forman – A grizzled U.S. Treasury bulldog who's one "dumbass" away from retirement.

Eric Peterson as Oscar Leroy – A retired Mountie dragged back into duty to provide "Canadian insight."

They hate each other instantly but are united in mutual exasperation.

Red: "You're telling me two gas-station morons broke the NASDAQ?" Oscar: "Well, you let Elon Musk tweet, didn't ya?"

★ The Wild Card

Lorne Cardinal as Davis Quinton – Dog River's finest and the RCMP's "cyber expert," whose credentials come from an unfinished online course titled Crypto for Cops.

Red: stares in aneurysm

The Secret Mastermind

Nancy Robertson as Wanda Dollard – Corner Gas's quick-witted cashier turned market oracle.

She started the whole fiasco as a prank to amuse herself, shorted the boys' company, and retired before lunch.

Wanda: "I made ten grand betting on stupidity. It's the most reliable commodity on earth."

She spends the finale sipping coffee at the till while everyone else gets arrested on live TV.

Mark The Climax

The investigation converges on Dog River.
Kelso and Hank barricade themselves inside Corner Gas.
Davis livestreams it to TikTok.
Crypto Rick tries to sell NFTs of the arrest.
Oscar argues jurisdiction.
Red Forman threatens to ground the entire country.

Red: "This is why I hate the internet."

Cue BTO's "Takin' Care of Business." Wanda cashes out. Dog River goes viral. The markets crash.
