At the conclusion of graduation practice, seniors will participate in the traditional **Senior Walk**. **Students will begin the walk at 10:15 during the passing period and will end their walk in the courtyard.** Parents can gather in the courtyard for this Senior Walk event.

Prohibited Items

VERY IMPORTANT - CAP AND GOWNS SHOULD NOT BE IRONED BUT STEAMED.

STUDENT CHECK-IN:

- It is mandatory that ALL Seniors check-in upon arriving at Credit Union of Texas Event Center.
- Check-in time is at 8:30 AM in the back staging area.
- We highly recommend that students leave valuable items such as phones, purses and cameras etc. with family members and not bring them in the staging and check-in area.
- ALL students will remain in the staging area after checking-in.

STUDENT ATTIRE:

Cap and gown with tassel are required for participation in the graduation ceremony. Any jewelry worn at graduation should not take away from the uniform look of the cap and gown. The temperature in the arena will be cooler due to the ice for the hockey games, so dress accordingly.

Students are NOT to decorate the tops of their caps.

Acceptable Attire:

- Girls – Dressy casual and dress shoes.
- Boys – Dress shirt and dress slacks.

Unacceptable Attire and Personal Items:

- Shorts
- Athletic Shoes
- Sunglasses
- Flip Flops
- Portable Electronic Devices - such as, but not limited to: phones, earbuds
- No flowers, corsages, buttons, tape ribbons, etc. may be worn

STUDENT CONDUCT:

This event will be conducted in a dignified manner. Seniors will conduct themselves in a way that will bring credit to themselves and their classmates. This ceremony is NOT the place for pranks, rude behavior, or other disruptive acts. Throwing items other than graduation caps at the appropriate time is not allowed. The Allen Event Center has asked that no one bring helium balloons, air horns, streamers, confetti, or other similar celebratory items.

Message from the Technology Department:

Chromebooks

The turn in day for all 12th grade chromebooks and chargers is Monday, May 20th at LHS in the commons. The tech staff will be on hand to inventory and document your machine and charger. Please be prepared to pay any associated fines for missing chargers, broken screens, keyboards, or missing devices. Students with device insurance will not be required to pay fines for breakage.

Student Data

Graduating Seniors should not expect retention of their google data beyond graduation. Once the end-of-the-year roll up in our Student Information System is performed Mid-June, all current seniors that have qualified for graduation will be designated as such in our student information systems. At this point, students should no longer expect access to Lovejoy ISD google accounts and google drive storage. **Students should login to Google Drive, consolidate data into folders, right click the folder, and then select "download" to transition their data to a personal computer or storage device. Any contacts, emails, or bookmarks that need to be retained should be downloaded or forwarded to personal accounts.**

Associated Accounts

If you utilized your district google account to create third party accounts, you will need to transfer ownership of that account to a personal email before leaving the district.
