## **Position Job Duties**

Req# 530903\_CT1 Alarms Technician

100% Inspect, test, and maintain fire and security alarm systems.

Collect data from newly installed equipment and locate and label existing equipment.

Research blueprints for equipment locations and information, make follow up inspections, and submit redlines to update prints.

Work under the direction of alarms technicians to learn campus alarm systems.

Must possess or be willing and able to acquire all necessary licenses required to perform essential functions of position. (NICET certifications, State of Alaska Fire System Permit)

Diagnose, troubleshoot, and repair fire and security alarms.

Perform all other duties as assigned.

Must be willing to work extra hours as requested to perform this job successfully. Once trained this position will be required to be on-call periodically during off-duty hours. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to stand; walk; use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl, and talk to hear. Must frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds.

Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, night vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.
